May I please request your response to the following:


1. Would the Department support an amendment to increase the refrigerator size to a maximum of 17.6 cubic feet to allow for increased food storage within kitchenettes only?

As there may be property owners who have submitted permit applications for dwelling units containing more than one wet bar, should Bill 104 be amended to allow for those permit applications to be processed if it was submitted before Bill 104's effective date?
