Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on February 14, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-41, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED PUBLIC REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF WORKS, KIHEI-MAKENA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, DRAINAGE, SOUTH KIHEI ROAD **CULVERT** REPLACEMENT WAIAKOA; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL **APPROPRIATIONS** (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by 1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$2,100,000; and 2) adding an appropriation of \$2,100,000 under the Department of Public Works, Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area, Drainage, Bond Fund, for the South Kihei Road Culvert Replacement at Waiakoa.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (SOUTH KIHEI ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT AT WAIAKOA)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding an appropriation of \$2,100,000 under the Department

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, KIHEI-MAKENA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, SOUTH KIHEI ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT AT WAIAKOA."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding an appropriation of \$2,100,000 under the Department of Public Works, Kihei-Makena Community Plan Area, for the South Kihei Road Culvert Replacement at Waiakoa.

Your Committee notes in the Fiscal Year 2014 Budget, \$1,600,000 of general obligation bond funds were appropriated for the project. The funds lapsed on December 31, 2014, because of permitting issues.

Your Committee notes in the Fiscal Year 2016 Budget, \$1,600,000 of general obligation funds were appropriated for the project. The Department expended \$13,750 for the design phase and the remaining \$1,586,250 lapsed on December 31, 2016, because of insufficient funds to execute a contract for the project.

Your Committee further notes the Nationwide Permit for the Waiakoa Culvert project authorized by the Department of the Army, United State Army Corps of Engineers, expires on March 18, 2017. A Nationwide Permit authorizes specific activities in areas under the Corps' Regulatory jurisdiction (navigable waterways, wetlands, etc.). Because the Department of Public Works issued a contract award letter based on the procurement process, a one-year extension to complete the construction of the project was granted. The permit will expire on March 18, 2018.

The Director of Public Works said the funds will be used for construction and construction management of the project. He noted an increase number of vacancies in the Construction Section of the Engineering Division therefore resulting in the need to contract for construction management.

He said the low bid of \$1,876,000 exceeded the amount of funds available for the project. He explained the Department could have utilized the Countywide Drainage appropriation to cover the \$300,000 shortfall and move the project forward, but because the emergency work for the September flood event depleted the appropriation, no funds were available to supplement the project.

The Director said the project site is at the entrance of Kihei on South Kihei Road, in a high-traffic area. He stated the project is ready to proceed once the funding is approved and the contractor has agreed to honor the bid price.

He said steel plates currently cover the culvert because the culvert is deteriorating. He explained the project will expand the culvert, as much as possible, to be able to handle more water. The Director did note the culvert is in a narrow location between two condominium buildings. The design will allow water to flow over the culvert, if needed.

Your Committee voted 7-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, King, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee members Crivello and Guzman were excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed bills as noted in items 1 and 3 listed above, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. <u>Authorization of General Obligation Bonds</u>. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$27,803,000] <u>\$29,903,000</u> (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. <u>Disposition of Bond Proceeds</u>. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (the "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members. determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement.
