Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on March 7, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-40, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, MOLOKAI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, MOLOKAI BASEYARD; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by 1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$3,236,000; and 2) increasing the appropriation by \$3,236,000 under the Department of Public Works, Molokai Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, for the Molokai Baseyard project.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (MOLOKAI BASEYARD)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is amend the Fiscal Year 2017 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by increasing the appropriation by \$3,236,000 under the Department of Public Works, Molokai Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, for the Molokai Baseyard project.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, MOLOKAI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, MOLOKAI BASEYARD."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by 1) increasing the appropriation by \$3,236,000 under the Department of Public Works, Molokai Community Plan Area, for the Molokai Baseyard project; and 2) revising the description of the project.

The Director of Public Works provided a background of the proposed project for the Molokai Baseyard. He said land was purchased just outside of the Kaunakakai district. The land is to be used for a baseyard, and constructed in two phases.

He explained to your Committee \$8,000,000 was available for Phase I of the project and a contract was executed. However, a change order for \$1,500,000 was presented to the Department by the contractor for work relating to the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Department requested a detailed breakdown of the change order, but insufficient information was provided by the contractor therefore the contract was cancelled. The funds lapsed before the Department could execute a new contract.

He said the Department requested Council reappropriate funds for the project. The estimated cost for Phase I and II of the project was \$14,500,000. Council declined to approve funding for the project. Citing the high-cost factor and over-design of the project, the Council instead requested a redesign of the project.

The Director said his Department contracted for redesign of the facility, as well as requested assistance from the Capital Improvement Project team situated in the Department of Management. Upon completion

of the redesign, \$5,000,000 was appropriated for the project in Fiscal Year 2017.

The project was streamlined into one phase instead of two by: 1) removal of unnecessary retaining walls; 2) consolidation of buildings; and 3) redesign of the layout for efficiency. The project was reassessed to include only items needed to be a functional baseyard. For example, a fancy roof was eliminated from the project, while keeping the proposed butler building a solidly constructed facility that will serve the community for many years. More importantly, the new facility will address the needs of the employees at the baseyard.

The Director said a request for proposals was issued; however, both the lowest and second lowest bidders were deemed non-compliant and the bids were rejected. Based on the bids received, the Department determined the \$5,000,000 appropriated for the project would be insufficient; therefore, the Department is requesting an increase of \$3,236,000 for the project.

He noted the total budget for the project of \$8,236,000 is significantly lower than the original estimate of \$14,500,000. The proposed budget includes the cost of construction, construction management, and Maui Electric Company charges.

The Director indicated once the funds are appropriated, the Department intends to re-bid the project. Barring any bid protests or complications, the Department plans to proceed with executing a contract, completing the permitting process, and starting construction by the end of the calendar year.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye."

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed bills, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel,

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (MOLOKAI BASEYARD)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. <u>Authorization of General Obligation Bonds</u>. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$29,903,000] <u>\$33,139,000</u> (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (the "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
