Testimony Regarding PC 14 - related to process of citizen advisory committee advice to Council regarding planning director proposed updates to community plans

Chairperson Kelly King and Members of this Committee,

I ask this Committee to recommend that the Maui Island Plan be repealed.

When the Council participated in the establishment of community plan boundary amendments in the Paia Haiku Community Plan Region proposed by a Planning Director in 1995; it received and considered advice from a duly established citizen advisory committee composed of citizens residing in the area. The Council then acted upon the proposed revision considering CAC advice.

This planning process established by Maui Charter and Maui County Code in the 1990's was displaced with the creation of the Maui Island Plan.

In creating the Maui Island Plan, the Council acted upon proposed community plan boundary amendments without receiving from the Director advice from a Paia Haiku Community plan citizen advisory committee with its recommendations. It broke the trust necessary for there to be governance by a separation of powers. I ask that this Committee recommend the repeal of the Maui Island Plan. I ask that this Committee initiate a return to the rule of law
