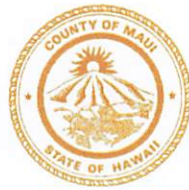

**SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET
(DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION)**

On behalf of the Department of Parks and Recreation, I am transmitting the following:

1. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2023 Budget by increasing the estimated revenues for Carryover/Savings from the General Fund by \$1,118,516 and appropriating the funds to the Department of Parks and Recreation. The proposed bill would also increase equivalent personnel by 10.0.



2. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Carryover/Savings from the General Fund for \$1,118,516.

Additional funds is needed to properly address the staffing and operational requirements for the additional parks acquired through Resolution 22-208. The department recognizes the benefit of the acquisition of various park parcels for the preservation of park, open space, and shoreline access and will require planning and operational funding to be able to manage and maintain these parcels.
