Over 133-acres of Ag zoned lands across from The Haiku Community Center are for sale and deserve immediate preservation. These parcels contain the traditional access road to the Pauwela Lighthouse, which the County owns. The lot most makai is 82 acres and is being sold for \$3.5M. The next lot mauka is 44 acres is being sold for \$2.0M. The last lot is next to Hana Hwy, is 6.7 acres and is being sold for \$1.3M. Total acreage is 133 acres.

Why should these lands be protected: These historically important lands hold a traditional Mauka-Makai trail to Puniawa Bay (aka "K-Bay") and the County's Pauwela Lighthouse park. Public trails through private lands regularly


