Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on March 7, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-38, from the Budget Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by expanding the project descriptions provided for each Capital Improvement Project by adding "design" or "construction" to various descriptions for the Department of Environmental Management, Department of Parks and Recreation, and Department of Public Works.

By correspondence dated February 3, 2017, the Budget Director transmitted a revised proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C – CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, DEPARTMENT OF WATER SUPPLY." The purpose of the revised proposed bill is to expand various project descriptions, including the Department of Water Supply.

The Budget Director said the proposed amendment to Appendix C relating to the description of various projects will allow the Departments to proceed with the necessary work for the project. The proposed revised

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descriptions which include adding "design" or "construction" will allow more flexibility to the project scope.

Your Committee requested clarification of CBS-1132, Countywide Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Compliance Projects Consent Decree as it relates to the deletion of "sewer lines" with the insertion of "wastewater infrastructure" in the project description. The project stems from a 1999 Consent Decree.

The Deputy Director of Environmental Management explained there are instances when the actual work involves more than improvements to the sewer line. To assure compliance with the project description, the language is modified to avoid any discrepancy. He noted the proposed change is consistent with the 1999 Consent Decree.

He acknowledged the County has fulfilled its requirements of the 1999 Consent Decree, but programs established under the Decree are on-going to prevent the possibility of future violations and consent decrees.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye."

Your Committee is in receipt of a further revised proposed bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget.
