A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A
OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018,
EMERGENCY FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4456, Bill No. 65 (2017), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget", Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2018, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Emergency Fund, by adding a proviso, to read as follows:

## "II. SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018

- K. Emergency Fund (Section 9-14, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended; Chapter 3.96, Maui County Code)
  - (1) Provided, that \$500,000 shall be for the emergency removal of 60 eucalyptus trees in the County-owned right of way along Piiholo Road that pose an imminent danger of death, injury, and property damage to residents and visitors utilizing Piiholo Road; and may also be used for a cost-sharing agreement with Piiholo Ranch for the removal of 300 trees on Piiholo Ranch property that create similar hazards."

SECTION 2. New material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
