SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR ("FY") 2025 BUDGET (BFED-1) (PW-1)

The Department is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 19, 2024 requesting information on our FY2025 Budget and is providing the following responses.

- 1. Please outline the major changes in your Department's budget from FY 2024 to FY 2025.
 - a. Explain any budget changes made because of the August 2023 wildfires.
 - Increased premium pay in the Highways Administration and Road Bridge Drainage Maintenance Programs and to support wildfire debris removal operations and infrastructure restoration.

- Expansion Positions in Highways Road Bridge Drainage Maintenance Program.
 - Lahaina District: One Highways Construction & Maintenance
 Supervisor II and two Laborer II's to support wildfire recovery efforts and the district's maintenance needs.
 - Pavement Preservation: One Highways Utility Worker to improve efficiency of paving operations.
 - Traffic Signs and Markings Program: One Traffic Signs & Markings
 Supervisor II to fill a gap in the supervisory structure for this program.
- Increase professional services in the Engineering Program for surveying services to support wildfire recovery and for Flood Program permit review and audit.
- b. If your budget will decrease, how will this impact your Department's operations and ability to serve the public?

No decreases are proposed.

- 2. How many vacant positions currently exist within your Department?
 - a. Please include the job titles for the vacancies and indicate how long the positions have been vacant.

There are 51 vacant positions as of March 25, 2024. The attached report titled "Public Works Open Positions as of 03/25/24" provides the job titles and the column labeled "Earliest Hire Date" represents the date the vacancy began.

b. What is the anticipated timeline for filling these vacancies?

The attached vacancy report includes a column labeled "Job Requisition" which indicates that a requisition has been submitted to fill the position. Each requisition takes 2-3 months to complete all steps involved, which includes the job posting, applicant screening, applicant interviews, selection of hire, job offer, applicant acceptance of offer, pre-hire screening, and onboarding.

c. What are the consequences, if any, for removing funding for these vacant positions from the FY 2025 Budget?

By eliminating the funding, it creates uncertainty about whether the Department is authorized to fill these vacanices. Reductions in salary funding to no less than 6 months of funding would be reasonable and allow the Department to operate without impact through the first half of the fiscal year. By then the Department is better aware of its funding needs for the year and has time to seek a budget amendment if additional funding is needed.

3. If your Department had expansion positions in the FY 2024 Budget, how many of those positions were filled? If they have not been filled, are they included in the FY 2025 Budget? How many months of funding are being requested?

The Department was unable to complete the hiring process for its FY2024 expansion positions due to the impacts of the wildfires, staff turnover within the Department's Administration Program, and the increased workload from the numerous expansion positions received by the Department in recent budgets. The Department has requested a full year of funding in FY2025 for all FY2024 expansion positions as is typically done in the year following approval of an expansion position.

4. If your Department is proposing expansion positions in the FY 2025 Budget, how do you plan to fill those positions?

The positions will be filled either by open recruitment or promotions.

5. How many positions were filled in FY 2024 that were not expansion positions?

As of March 25, 2024, the Department filed 32 positions. None of these positions were FY2024 expansion positions.

6. How did your Department recruit to fill vacancies and what were the most effective methods for attracting candidates?

Due to the impacts of the wildfires the Department was unavailable to participate in recruiting efforts outside of the typical recruitment services provided by the Department of Personnel Services.

b. Were any of these overtime costs attributed to the number of vacant positions in your Department?

Yes, vacant positions are the leading cause for overtime.

c. Do you anticipate that overtime costs in FY 2025 will increase or decrease and what are the reasons for your assumption?

The Department's FY2025 Budget proposal reflects an increase in overtime costs from the FY2024 Budget based on the actual overtime expenses incurred in FY2024. With the struggle to fill vacancies, we anticipate increases in overtime costs as new vacancies are created from retirements and staff turnover.

- 8. The following questions are related to your Department's program and activities:
 - a. Identify the programs and activities conducted by your Department because of a Federal or State mandate. Indicate the amount of Federal or State funding the County receives for each program or activity, including how much for each the County expends.

Most all programs of the Department are the result of mandates or authorities that are assigned to the County by Federal and State laws or are necessary to remain eligible for Federal and State funding programs. The following are programs that are mandated to the County or regulated and enforcement by Federal or State agencies.

<u>Federal-Aid Highway Program</u>: The Department must meet Federal and State requirements to remain eligible for federal-aid funding to repair and construct county federal-aid roads. The cost share for a federal-aid project is 80% federal and 20% county. However, all ancillary costs to design, permit, and administer federal-aid projects are paid by the County. Typically, the County receives \$12.5 million per year in federal-aid funding but requires \$8-10 million in County funding for the ancillary costs.

National Bridge Inspection Standards (NBIS): The Department must inspect all its bridges with spans of 20-ft or greater in accordance with the NBIS requirements to remain eligible for federal-aid funding. The Engineering Program expends on average \$150,000 to \$200,000 annually in engineering consultant services.

<u>Federal Flood Control Program</u>: The County is the local sponsor for the lao and Kahoma Flood Control projects overseen by the US Army Corp of Engineers. Federal funding is available for certain projects to repair or modify the flood control structures. The County is responsible for all maintenance costs. The Highways Special Maintenance and Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Programs and the Engineering Programs all have various expenditures to support the flood control program.

State Dam Safety Program: The County owns and operates several flood control dams in West Maui that are subject to the State DLNR Dam Safety regulations. The County is responsible for all maintenance costs. Federal funding is available for certain projects to repair or modify dam structures. The Highways Special Maintenance and Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Programs and the Engineering Programs all have various expenditures to support the flood control program.

<u>Veteran Cemeteries (HRS 363, MCC 13.20)</u>: The operation and maintenance of veteran cemeteries by the County is mandated by the State and must be performed in accordance with the Federal standards for veteran cemeteries. The State provides partial reimbursement (\$734-\$948 per burial) but most costs are paid by the County under the Highways Special Maintenance and Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Programs.

Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Program: The operation and maintenance of the County's storm drainage system in the Census designated urbanized areas with populations of 50,000 or more people (Paia, Kahului, Wailuku, Waikapu, Waiehu, and Waihee) is regulated by an NPDES permit issued by the State Department of Health pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act. The Highways Special Maintenance and Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Programs have various expenditures to support the MS4 program.

National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP, HRS 46-11, MCC 16.29): The County must regulate development in flood hazard areas in accordance with the FEMA NFIP so that properties are eligible for flood insurance. There is no state or federal reimbursement to operate this program. The Engineering Program will begin incurring costs as the program is transferred from the Planning Department.

<u>Subdivision and Building Codes (HRS 46-1.5(14), MCC Title 18, MCC Title 16)</u>: The County must regulate and enforce the State Building Codes and the subdivision of land within the County. There is no state or federal reimbursement to operate this program. While revenue is generated from permit fees, the fees are not intended to achieve full cost recovery. The DSA and Engineering Programs have expenditures to support administration of subdivision and building codes.

<u>Drainageway Maintenance (HRS 46-1.5(5), HRS 46-1.5, MCC 12.12)</u>: The County must perform maintenance of drainageways and enforce against owners that fail to maintain their drainageways pursuant to State and County laws. Each of the Department's programs (Highways, DSA, and Engineering) have expenditures to support the operations and enforcement of drainageway maintenance.

Public Nuisance Abatement (HRS 46-1.5(10), HRS 46-12, MCC 9.32, MCC 20.20): The County must enforce against and abate public nuisances. The Highways Special Maintenance and Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Programs and the DSA Programs all have various expenditures to support the

public nuisance abatement. Expenditures vary by year based on the number of nuisance cases received. Activities performed include administrative enforcement proceedings and abatement activity (i.e. cleanups, signage, barricades, and gates) on beaches, roadways, and private property.

Streetlighting of County Roads (HRS 46-1.5(19), MCC 20.02): The County must operate and maintain all streetlights on County roads. The Engineering Division and Highways Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Programs have expenditures related to the operations, installation, and replacement of streetlights. The County arrangement for streetlighting is for HECO to own and operate all streetlights and the County pays for the electricity costs. No federal or state funding is available for these costs. In FY23, the Department expended \$2.6 million on electricity for streetlights.

Operations and Maintenance of County Roads (HRS 46-15.9, HRS 46-16, HRS 46-1.5(19), MCC 12.02, MCC 12.04, MCC 12.50): The County must oversee, operate, and maintain the County's roads, inclusive of its safety, stability, pavement condition, vegetation, traffic signals, traffic control devices, traffic capacity, storm drainage, and work performed by utility companies. Each of the Department's programs (Highways, DSA, and Engineering) have expenditures to support the oversight and operations of the County's roads. Except for funding provided by the Federal-Aid Highway Program, no other outside funds are available for the operations and maintenance of the County roads.

Central Coordinating Agency (HRS 46-18, MCC 2.16): The Department is assigned to service the Central Coordination Agency for the County as required by State law. The activities of the DSA Program serve to support this function. No outside funding is available to support this function.

b. Identify the programs and activities conducted solely because of a Maui County Code mandate and indicate the amount for each the County expends.

Most other programs within the Department are the result of mandates in the County of Maui Charter and Maui County Code. The following are programs that are stipulated by Maui County Code:

Street Trees (MCC 12.24A): The Department is responsible for the oversight and maintenance of street trees in County roads. The Highways Special Maintenace Program and Highways Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Programs have expenditures related to the oversight and maintenance street trees. Annual expenditures for tree services procured by the Department averages \$400,000 to \$500,000 and is paid by the Highway Beautification Revolving Fund and the General Fund. Highway Fund expenditures also support tree maintenance and clearing performed by the Highways Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Program. No outside funding is received for these activities.

Grading and Grubbing (MCC 20.08): The Department is responsible for administering and enforcing grading and grubbing activities in the County. The DSA and Engineering Programs have expenditures to support these activities. Expenditures vary by year based on the number of grading cases and complaints received. Some revenue is generated by permit fees, but all other costs are paid by the General Fund. No outside funding is received for these activities.

Outdoor Lighting (MCC 20.35): The Department administers and enforces the use and placement of outdoor lighting fixtures in the County. The DSA Electrical Permit Section has expenditures related to these activities. Expenditures vary by year based on the number of grading cases and complaints received. Some revenue is generated by permit fees, but all other costs are paid by the General Fund. No outside funding is received for these activities.

- 9. If your Department had Capital Improvement Projects ("CIPs") in FY 2024:
 - a. Provide the current status of each CIP project, if different from the information provided in the Fiscal Year 2024 2nd Quarter CIP Report.

All of the Department's CIP projects are to ensure the good working order of critical infrastructure and are all priority. The least critical projects would be those contained in CBS No. 7232 Countywide DPW Baseyard Facilities Program related to baseyard projects.

b. Will CIP funding included in the FY 2025 Budget be encumbered by June 30, 2025? If not, how much do you anticipate will be encumbered by that date?

The Department strives to encumber all its CIP funding as soon as possible. However, there are always complications with project design and permitting that can delay when projects are bid out for construction. The CIP Budget is an 18-month funding cycle and the Department often relies upon the full 18 months to encumber its CIP construction contracts.

- 11. If your Department manages a revolving fund:
 - a. Explain whether the revolving fund is still needed and why.

The DSA Program administers the Plan Review Permit Processing and Inspection Revolving Fund. This fund is necessary to receive the revenues collected from plan review fees and to ensure funding is set aside for building permit services including plan review, permit processing, and inspections.

The Highways Beautification Revolving Fund is necessary to receive revenues collected pursuant to MCC 3.25.030 and MCC 20.20.080 and to ensure funding is set aside for the maintenance of street trees.

b. Provide the current balance.

The Plan Review Revolving Fund Balance (as of Feb 2024) \$8,127,446. The full balance of the Highway Beautification Revolving Fund is appropriated each year.

DPW doesn't have any grants subsidies to outside entities proposed in FY25.

b. Provide a breakdown of all grants that will be funded by your Department under Subobject Code 6317, County grant subsidy.

Not applicable. See response above to item 12.a.

13. Provide details on your Department's Carryover/Savings that were included in the FY 2025 Budget.

Carryover/Savings included in the FY 2025 Budget are determined by Budget Office in coordination with the Finance Department. Per Budget Office, the carryover savings included in the FY 2025 budget are from the unrestricted fund balance for FY 2023 reflected in the County's Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR). Any carryover savings from FY 2024 will be recognized in the FY 2026 budget.

14. What are your top three Department priorities for FY 2025 and how does your Department's budget reflect that?

The Department's top 3 priorities are:

- 1. Support the Maui Wildfire Recovery. Much of this funding is reflected as premium pay and will be included in the Office of Recovery's proposed budget.
- 2. Maintain continuity of operations. The Maui Wildfires has placed an immense burden on the Department's programs with each program having significant roles in supporting the fire debris cleanup, infrastructure repairs, and rebuilding activities. Maintaining the Department's capacity to support wildfire response while maintaining regular operations is the focus of the Department in FY25. This is reflected in our FY25 Budget proposal by the limited number of new funding requests being made.

- 15. Keep up with the CIP Program. There are increases in professional services being sought to ensure the Department can keep up with its CIP Program. The demand to deliver on CIP projects has never been greater for the Department with the growing asset inventory, increased frequency of severe weather events and emergency repairs, and the monumental effort to rebuild Lahaina.
- 16. Did your Department apply for any grant funding in FY 2024? If yes, how much in funding was received?

19. Provide a list of equipment, locations, and structures used or managed by your Department that was destroyed in the wildfires. Explain for each whether your Department plans to repair or replace it. If it will be repaired or replaced, provide the estimated cost and timeline for the repair or replacement.

None of the Department's buildings or equipment were damaged by the wildfires. However, damages to roadway pavements, traffic signs and markings, traffic signals, and drainage infrastructure was experienced. The Department does intend to replace all its damaged assets as they will all be necessary to support repopulation of Lahaina Town. Numerous temporary repairs will be necessary in the interim to support ongoing recovery efforts. Most repairs will not occur for a few years until after debris removal operation and underground infrastructure repairs are complete. Currently only approximations are available as damage assessments are still ongoing. Current estimates project over \$15 million in damages.

SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR ("FY") 2025 BUDGET (BFED-1) (PW-1)

The Department is in receipt of your correspondence dated March 19, 2024 requesting information on our FY2025 Budget and provided a response dated April 2, 2024. The Department has additional information and provides the revised responses (in red) to question 1:

- 1. Please outline the major changes in your Department's budget from FY 2024 to FY 2025.
 - a. Explain any budget changes made because of the August 2023 wildfires.
 - Increased premium pay in the Highways Administration and Road Bridge Drainage Maintenance Programs to support wildfire debris removal operations and infrastructure restoration.
 - Expansion position in Administration Program
 - Secretary III to support Deputy Director to better assist Director in performing duties supporting Public Works Commission, serving on

numerous boards and commissions, appearing regularly before multiple Council Committees and engaging with numerous CIP and development consultants.

- Expansion positions in Special Maintenance Program
 - Fleet Mechanic to support additional fleet equipment and vehicles being added to support safe and effective roadway vegetation management and pavement preservation.
 - Fleet Technician to support the additional vehicles and equipment being added to support safe and effective roadway vegetation management and road maintenance for the Wailuku district.
 - Equipment Operator Trainer position to support the equipment and driver training program that Highways Division provides as a critical service to internal departments for training and support of commercial drivers.
- Expansion positions in Highways Road Bridge Drainage Maintenance Program and Traffic Management Program.
 - Lahaina District: One Highways Construction & Maintenance
 Supervisor II and two Laborer II's to support wildfire recovery efforts and the district's maintenance needs.
 - Pavement Preservation: One Highways Utility Worker to improve efficiency of paving operations.
 - Traffic Signs and Markings Program: One Traffic Signs & Markings
 Supervisor II to fill a gap in the supervisory structure for this program.

Increase professional services in the Engineering Program for surveying services to support wildfire recovery and for Flood Program permit review and audit.
