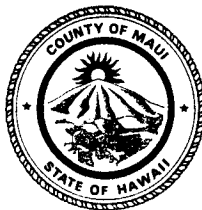

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated May 25, 2018, Acting Mayor Keith A. Regan notified the Council he nominated Tanya Grieg to the Maui County Cultural Resources Commission for a term expiring on March 31, 2022, to fill a vacancy replacing Timothy Bailey, pursuant to Sections 2.40.110 and 2.88.030, Maui County Code, and Section 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, ("Charter"); and


WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor's nominee to be approved by the Council; and

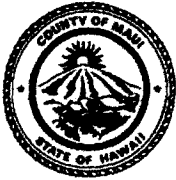
