

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS
FOR THE MANAGING DIRECTOR, CORPORATION COUNSEL, AND
PROSECUTING ATTORNEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish additional qualifications for the Managing Director, Corporation Counsel, and Prosecuting Attorney, pursuant to Section 6-4, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended (“Charter”). Section 6-4 of the Charter authorizes the Council to establish specific qualifications for administrative heads appointed by the Mayor in addition to any set forth in the Charter. More specific qualifications will help identify skilled, experienced individuals to lead the County’s departments, strengthen operations, and better serve the public.

SECTION 2. Chapter 2.14, Maui County Code, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

“2.14.100 Managing director. The managing director shall have the following minimum qualifications:

1. As set forth in the charter, five years of experience in an administrative capacity, either in public or private business, or both.

2. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of responsible managerial and budgetary experience.

3. As a part of or in addition to the five years of administrative experience, three years of experience in one or more of the following functions:

a. Acting as the principal management aide to a chief executive officer.

b. Supervising the administrative functions of agencies, departments, and boards and commissions.

c. Evaluating the management and performance of agencies under his or her supervision.

d. Prescribing standards of administrative practice to be followed by agencies under his or her supervision.

e. Supervising and coordinating the preparation and submittal of an annual operating budget and a capital program.

f. Supervising and coordinating the control, management, and execution of an annual operating budget and capital program.

g. Supervising and coordinating a systematic and continual review of the finances, organizations, and methods of each department to assist in achieving the most effective expenditure of funds and to determine that such expenditures are in accordance with budget laws and controls in force.

4. A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in business administration, public administration, or other relevant discipline, or a combination of education and work experience substantially equivalent to such a bachelor's degree."

SECTION 3. Chapter 2.14, Maui County Code, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

"2.14.110 Corporation counsel. The corporation counsel shall have the following minimum qualifications:

1. As set forth in the charter, the corporation counsel shall be an attorney licensed to practice and in good standing before the Supreme Court of the State.

2. As set forth in the charter, the corporation counsel shall have engaged in the practice of law for five years.

3. As a part of or in addition to the five years of experience in the practice of law, three years of civil litigation experience.

4. As a part of or in addition to the five years of experience in the practice of law, three years of responsible managerial and budgetary experience.

5. As a part of or in addition to the five years of experience in the practice of law, three years of experience in one or more of the following functions:

a. Serving as chief legal advisor or legal representative of a municipality or other governmental entity, its departments, boards and commissions, or officers and employees in matters relating to their official duties.

b. Representing a public or private entity in legal proceedings.

6. A juris doctor degree from an accredited law school.”

SECTION 4. Chapter 2.14, Maui County Code, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

“2.14.120 Prosecuting attorney. The prosecuting attorney shall have the following minimum qualifications:

1. As set forth in the charter, the prosecuting attorney shall be an attorney licensed to practice and in good standing before the Supreme Court of the State.

2. As set forth in the charter, the prosecuting attorney shall have engaged in the practice of law for five years.

3. As a part of in addition to the five years of experience in the practice of law, three years of criminal litigation experience.

4. As a part of or in addition to the five years of experience in the practice of law, three years of responsible managerial and budgetary experience.

5. As a part of or in addition to the five years of experience in the practice of law, three years of experience in one or more of the following functions:

a. Attending all courts in the jurisdiction and conducting, on behalf of the people, prosecutions for offenses against the laws of the State and applicable ordinances and rules.

b. Appearing in criminal cases where there is a change of venue and prosecuting those cases in any jurisdiction to which those cases have been changed or removed.

c. Instituting proceedings, or directing the chief of police to institute proceedings, before a judge of a court of competent jurisdiction for the arrest of

persons charged with or reasonably suspected of public offenses.

d. Drawing indictments and attending before the grand jury when cases are presented to it for consideration.

e. Prosecuting administrative violations of the liquor laws before the liquor adjudication board.

4. A juris doctor degree from an accredited law school.”

SECTION 5. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the underscoring.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect on January 2, 2019.
