Aloha kakou,

I'm sending this email out of concern for the lack of community engagement regarding the planned drilling for water in Ha'iku.

The 30 year old, outdated Maui Island Water Use and Development Plan includes a strategy to drill deep wells into the Haiku aquifer. Millions of gallons of water a day would be sent to central and south Maui.

The well strategy is being put forward even though no geologic, environmental or stream use studies have been done on the Haiku aquifer, according to Jeffrey Parker, Director of the Coalition to Protect East Maui Water Resources.

Ha'iku citizens need an online "town hall" on the WUDP, before it has its first Council vote, since they are the area where the most water is planned to be developed for others.
