

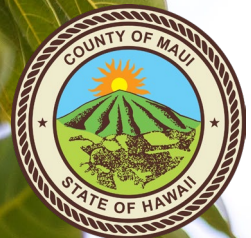

CDBG PROGRAM

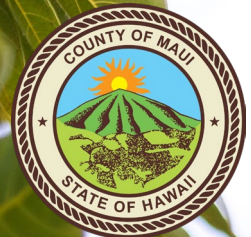
- Created by Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383).
- The County of Maui, a non-entitlement county in Hawaii, has participated in the CDBG Program since its inception and received its first allocation of \$454,000 in 1975.
- CDBG funds are allocated annually by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on a formula basis, as established by HUD.



CDBG PRIMARY OBJECTIVES

- Availability and sustainability of a suitable living environment
- Availability, affordability and sustainability of decent housing
- Availability and sustainability of economic opportunity

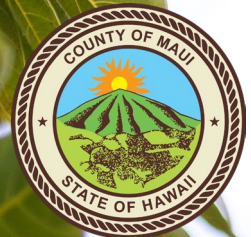
Principally for persons of low-and moderate-income.



CDBG NATIONAL OBJECTIVES

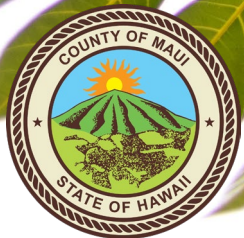
Proposed activities seeking CDBG funding must meet **one** of the following:

- Principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons or families
- Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight
- Meet an urgent need



CDBG ALLOCATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/PROGRAM YEAR 2024

The County's CDBG funding for Program Year 2024 is anticipated to be \$1,829,334 with \$1,463,467 awarded to projects.

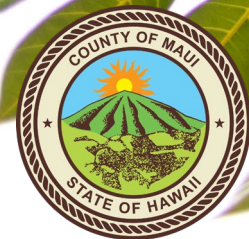


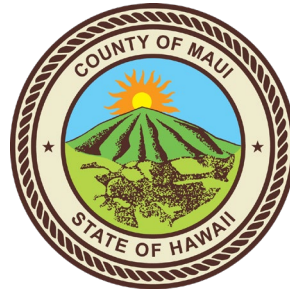

Senior Affordable Rental Housing	Operations: Annual obligation to support the operation of units acquired for income-eligible Kupuna displaced by the Maui Wildfires.	\$ 100,000.00
Maui Wildfire Recovery	Resiliency Center Acquisition: Acquisition to support a Resiliency Center dedicated to serving the survivors of the Maui Wildfires. The Center will create spaces for mental health counseling, healing activities and wrap-around services for Maui Wildfire survivors.	\$1,363,468.00
