BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:


SECTION 1. Ordinance 5816, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2026 Budget," Section 3.B.11.c.(1).(ii)., Department of Management, Office of Recovery Program, General, is amended to update the conditional language for the Lahaina Restoration Foundation to delete Waiola Church and insert Hale Aloha, to read as follows:


