A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, UPDATING THE CONDITIONAL LANGUAGE FOR THE MAKAWAO RODEO PARADE AND MAKAWAO HOLIDAY 2025 LIGHT THE TOWN EVENT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 5816, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2026 Budget," Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xii), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, Makawao-Pā'ia-Ha'ikū Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs, is amended to update the conditional language for the Makawao Rodeo Parade and Makawao Halloween Event to "Makawao Rodeo Parade and Makawao Holiday 2025 Light the Town Event", to read as follows:

 - (f) Up to \$15,000 for Kaizen Group Inc., for a surfing event.

(g) Up to \$30,000 for Makawao-Pā'ia-Ha'ikū Residency Area cleanup efforts, security, beautification, maintenance, community outreach, educational events, and economic development.
