Subject: Filming Ordinance

Yuki – Thanks for listening to my concerns on the filming ordinance revisions. I like that they have put neighbor complaints into the ordinance but to keep it at 500 feet defeats the purpose!

For instance, in our neighborhood we all live in 2 acres or a little over. Property lines measure 300-400 feet in most cases. During the MTV filming, only the lots touching the parcel where the filming occurred were notified by the land owner. This left a majority of the neighborhood out relative to the notifications. The 500 foot distance leaves no opportunity for those in the neighborhood who are impacted, but live 2-3 lots away, any opportunity to be notice or file a complaint. This item needs to be increased back to 1000 feet at a minimum for all sections within the ordinance to give the neighbors on 2 acre parcels a chance! Even though the lots maybe larger, we all still share the same roadways and the impacts from the traffic in an out of a 2 street subdivision.

I will be there to testify to this. We are basically back to where we started with limited distance notification of 500 feet.

With the increase in commercial activity of all natures (B&B, Short Term Rentals, Filming, etc.) I think it is time the County alter the 500 foot notification for all ordinances, especially when the plots of land where people reside are over a ½ acre. This is a not a reasonable distance for the larger plots.
