BILL NO. 63 (2026)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 3.38.010 AND 3.38.020, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ON RENAMING THE HAWAIIAN CULTURAL RESTORATION REVOLVING FUND AND USING THE FUNDS TO EXPAND THE ROYAL LAHAINA COMPLEX AREA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. The Lahaina Royal Complex Master Plan, also known as Lu'ehu, is a project designed to establish a comprehensive community vision for significant cultural and historic sites in Lahaina. This area includes Moku'ula, Loko O Mokuhinia, Pākalā, and Loko O Nālehu, which formerly served as the political capital of the Hawaiian Kingdom.

The purpose of this amendment is to broaden the area beyond just Moku'ula, the ponds of Mokuhinia, and Pākalā so that the funds can be used for preservation and restoration throughout the Lahaina Royal Complex area.

SECTION 2. Section 3.38.010, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

“3.38.010 Fund established. There is established and created a fund to be known as the [“Hawaiian cultural restoration revolving fund.”] “Lahaina royal complex restoration revolving fund.” Proceeds collected from a legally established parking concession located on property under the control and management of the County on the area identified as tax map key number (2) 4-6-007:036 in Lahaina, Maui, [Hawaii shall] Hawai'i must be deposited in the fund.”

SECTION 3. Section 3.38.020, Maui County Code, is amended to read as

follows:

“3.38.020 Purpose. A. The [Hawaiian cultural restoration revolving fund] Lahaina royal complex restoration revolving fund must provide funds for the preservation and restoration of [Hawaiian historic and cultural] Lahaina royal complex sites and artifacts relating to Moku‘ula, the ponds of Mokuhinia, [and] Pākalā (including Kamehameha Iki Park), and Kamehameha III school and library areas makai of Front Street at Lahaina, Maui, Hawai‘i, including maintenance of the sites.


B. In adopting each fiscal year’s budget and capital program, the council may make appropriations to the fund. Any balance remaining in this fund at the end of the fiscal year must not lapse, but must remain in the fund accumulating from year to year.

C. The revenues in this fund must not be used for any purpose except those listed in subsection A.”

SECTION 4. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance takes effect on July 1, 2026.
