BILL NO. 107 (2025)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE NAMING HĀMĀKUALOA CULTURAL PRESERVE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Chapter 12.40, Maui County Code is amended by adding a new section to read as follows:

“12.40.330 Hāmākualoa Cultural Preserve. Hāmākualoa Cultural Preserve refers to the area identified as tax map keys (2) 2-7-007:079, (2) 2-7-007:005, (2) 2-7-007:081, (2) 2-7-007:082, and (2) 2-7-007:083 and located at Ha‘ikū Sugar East Subdivision, lots 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, Maui, Hawai‘i.”

SECTION 2. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.
