A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI,
OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM,
GRANTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT
AND TECHNOLOGY, SOUTH MAUI ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
ENVIRONMENTAL, AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5657, Bill No. 60, CD1, FD2 (2024), as amended "Fiscal Year 2025 Budget", Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xxiv), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, South Maui Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs, is amended to delete the condition for Kihei Youth Center, increase the condition for Kūlanihāko'i High School in the amount of \$5,000, delete the condition for Ma'alaea Village Association, and insert a new condition for Valley Isle Timing Association dba Maui Raceway Park for the retrofitting of lights and addressing safety concerns at the park, in the amount of \$50,000, to read as follows:

This bill proposes to amend the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget, Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xxiv), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, South Maui Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs, by deleting the condition for Kihei Youth Center, increasing the condition for Kūlanihāko'i High School in the amount of \$5,000, deleting the condition for Ma'alaea Village Association, and inserting a new condition for Valley Isle Timing Association dba Maui Raceway Park for the retrofitting of lights and addressing safety concerns at the park, in the amount of \$50,000.


