Chair and Members:

Your Budget and Finance Committee, having met on March 7, 2017, makes reference to County Communication 17-39, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES; DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA. GOVERNMENT FACILITIES, COUNTY SERVICE CENTER; CAPITAL **IMPROVEMENT PROJECT** APPROPRIATIONS; AND TOTAL **APPROPRIATIONS** (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)."

The purpose of the proposed bill to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget by 1) increasing Bond/Lapsed Bond by \$160,000; and 2) adding an appropriation of \$160,000 under the Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, Bond Fund, for the County Service Center project.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (COUNTY SERVICE CENTER)."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 general obligation bond authorization ordinance by adding an appropriation of \$160,000 under the Department

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of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, Government Facilities, for the County Service Center project.

3. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT, WAILUKU-KAHULUI COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, COUNTY SERVICE CENTER."

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by adding: 1) an appropriation of \$160,000 under the Department of Management, Wailuku-Kahului Community Plan Area, for the County Service Center project; and 2) a description of the project.

Your Committee notes Ordinance 4160, Bill 67 (2014), appropriated \$7,145,582 for the acquisition of 7 lots, composed of approximately 4.101 acres located in the Maui Business Park II, for a new service center in the Central Maui area.

Your Committee notes on January 16, 2015, the Council passed on second and final reading Ordinance 4187, Bill 95 (2014), which appropriated \$1,632,976 for planning and design of the new service center facility. In December 2015, Contract C5908 was executed with Group 70 International, Inc. for \$1,632,809.

Your Committee notes the current County Service Center located at the Maui Mall in Kahului is in leased space. The annual lease rent is approximately \$506,000.

The Managing Director said design for a new County Service Center is complete with the exception of a few minor adjustments. Overall, the design and construction drawings are ready for submittal to various agencies for permit review.

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He said the proposed funds will be for building permit fees, including building permit review fee, approximately \$40,000; fire prevention review fee, approximately \$20,000; Maui Electric Company review fee, \$10,000; Disability and Communication Access Board review fee, \$10,000; Archaeological Impact Survey and management fee, \$18,500; additional consultant fees, approximately \$40,000; and 15 percent contingency, \$20,000. He noted filing fees for development or permit applications as it relates to the planning review fee, on behalf of any County agency, could be waived by the Planning Director.

He explained fees could be waived for County projects if allowed by ordinance. Currently, the Department of Public Works and the Department of Fire and Public Safety do not have provisions to waive fees for County projects.

Your Committee expressed grave disappointment relating to the consultant's work on the design for the project. The facility will be constructed expending public funds, or taxpayer dollars, so amenities should not be excessive and be limited to what is needed or required to meet health and safety guidelines. Your Committee noted the facility is a public facility, which should be functional and appropriate to service the community's needs.

Your Committee voted 9-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Hokama, Vice-Chair White, and members Atay, Carroll, Cochran, Crivello, Guzman, King, and Sugimura voted "aye."

Your Committee is in receipt of revised proposed bills as noted in 1 and 2 above, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions that take into account prior amendments to the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4331, BILL NO. 59 (2016), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI (COUNTY SERVICE CENTER)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Authorization of General Obligation Bonds. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [\$33,139,000] \$33,299,000 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof."

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4331, Bill No. 59 (2016), is amended by amending Section 2 to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (the "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members. determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the

Fiscal Year 2017 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:
