Legislation: Bill 119 (2025), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.36.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ON PENALTIES FOR PROHIBITED NOISE VIOLATIONS."

Proposer: Shane M. Sinenci, Chair 
Water Authority, Social Services, and Parks Committee.

Description: The proposed amendments increase the fine amounts from \$100 to \$500 for the first offense and \$250 to \$750 for the second offense. Penalties for the third offense were amended to remove forfeiture based on concerns raised by the Departments of Police and Prosecuting Attorney in correspondence dated April 9, 2026, and April 23, 2026, respectively.

BILL NO. **119, CD1** (2025)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.36.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ON PENALTIES FOR PROHIBITED NOISE VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 9.36.040, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

“9.36.040 Penalty. A. For the first offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [of not less than \$25 but no more than \$100.] is \$500.


B. For the second offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [or not less than \$100 but no more than \$250.] is \$750.

C. For the third offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [of not less than \$250 but no more than \$500.] is \$1,000.”

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.

BILL NO. 119, CD1 (2025)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.36.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ON PENALTIES FOR PROHIBITED NOISE VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 9.36.040, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

“9.36.040 Penalty. A. For the first offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [of not less than \$25 but no more than \$100.] is \$250500.

B. For the second offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [or not less than \$100 but no more than \$250.] is \$500750.

C. For the third offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [of not less than \$250 but no more than \$500.] the penalty is :

1. — A fine of \$1,000;

2. — Forfeiture of the sound amplification system or components of the sound amplification system up to \$1,000 in value; or

3. — A combination of forfeiture and a fine totaling \$1,000.”

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.
