APPOINTING SARAH FREISTAT PAJIMOLA TO THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

WHEREAS, a vacancy on the Civil Service Commission for a term expiring March 31, 2026, was created on July 24, 2023, with the resignation of Megan Moniz; and

WHEREAS, a long-term vacancy was created following the transition to the Independent Nomination Board and new procedures under Section 13-2 of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended; and

WHEREAS, the long-term vacancy can now be filled under Section 2.41.050, Maui County Code, which took effect in its current form on March 11, 2025; and

WHEREAS, under Section 2.41.050, the Council and the Mayor have alternating 30-day opportunities to make a unilateral appointment to fill a long-term vacancy when Charter Section 13-2 does not provide another mechanism; and

WHEREAS, under Section 2.41.050, Maui County Code, the Council has until October 8, 2025, to make a unilateral appointment and fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the information for nominee Sarah Freistat Pajimola required under Section 2.41.020, Maui County Code, is in Exhibit "A"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

- 1. That under Section 2.41.050, Maui County Code, it appoints Sarah Freistat Pajimola to the Civil Service Commission, for a term expiring March 31, 2026; and
- 2. That certified copies of the Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Corporation Counsel, the Director of Personnel Services, and Sarah Freistat Pajimola.
