My name is Scott Matsuura and I am the President of the Kehalani Community Association. The Association represents over 2,100 residences in the Kehalani, Wailuku-Kahului Project District 3.

The Kehalani Community Association is in full support of Resolution 25-86 and humbly requests that in accordance with Section 3.44.015, Maui County Code, the Committee approve the conveyance of the Kehalani Roadway Lots to the County.

Our member homeowners have patiently waited for the dedication of the roads to the County as the various approvals related to Kehalani always contemplated that the internal roadways would be County roads.

While the roadways primarily serve our homeowners, they also provide access to DOE's Pu'u Kukui Elementary School and the County's Kehalani Mauka Park and bus stops, which serve the broader community. Olomea Street, Kamole Street, and the Kehalani Makai Parkway serve as a connector between Waiale Road and Honoapiilani Highway, use of which is not limited to our homeowners. Our members are primarily Maui residents and are a large part of our County's workforce, please consider this request with their best interest in mind.

Finally, we feel it is important to point out that a vote for this project is a vote in support of the Association and all our homeowners. The developer has been supportive of the Association and has done its best to fulfill its inherited obligations, including the dedication of these internal roadways, however, the approval of the conveyance of the Kehalani Roadway Lots to the County benefits all the 2,100+ residences of Kehalani.
