SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET

On behalf of the Department of Environmental Management, I am transmitting the attached proposed bill for the purpose of adding two provisos under Appendix A, Part II, Countywide Sewer Capital Improvement Reserve Fund, appropriating \$110,000 for the capital project entitled "Lahaina Wastewater Pump Station No. 3 Modifications", for which \$1,600,000 was appropriated in Fiscal Year 2016; and appropriating \$1,010,000 for the capital project entitled "Kihei No. 16 Pump Station Rehabilitation and Force Main Replacement", for which \$4,400,000 was appropriated in Fiscal Year 2016. Additional funding is requested due to an increase in bid amounts.

The Department of Environmental Management requests that this budget amendment be considered as soon as possible. Therefore, I respectfully request that this matter be referred to the appropriate Council committee for expeditious review, discussion and appropriate action. A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A
OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017,
COUNTYWIDE SEWER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT RESERVE FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4334, Bill No. 62 (2016), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2017 Budget", Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2017, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Countywide Sewer Capital Improvement Reserve Fund, by adding provisos, to read as follows:


SECTION 2. New material is underscored.

SUBJECT: FISCAL YEAR 2017 REQUEST FOR SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET

We are requesting supplemental funds of \$1,321,307 for two Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) and sludge disposal. The estimated shortfall is due to the increase in construction cost and rate increase of sludge disposal. To fund this request, we propose transferring funds from our reserve (index code 919002) to the various index codes.
