The Administration was notified that the Maui Film Festival would not be occurring this year due to the retirement of the founder. The Maui Economic Development Board has been working with the County on promoting the film industry in the County and Brian Kohne is currently planning a Wailuku Film Festival. The film festival will focus on student, made in Hawai'i, and indigenous filmmakers and will be a series of monthly or bi-monthly events beginning in the summer of 2025.
