**SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE AUTHORIZATION FOR  
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS (DEPARTMENT OF  
MANAGEMENT (INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DATA  
CENTER IMPROVEMENTS))**

On behalf of the Department of Management, I am re-transmitting the attached proposed bill to amend Ordinance 4985, Bill 34 (2019), by adding a project entitled "Information Technology Data Center Improvements" under the Department of Management and adding an appropriation of \$350,000.

At the January 10, 2020 Council meeting, two bills attached to County Communication 20-19 was passed on first reading; one to amend the FY 2020 Operating Budget and the other to amend Appendix C. The third bill, which amends the Authorization for General Obligation Bonds, was inadvertently omitted from the posted agenda.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4985,  
BILL NO. 34 (2019), RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL  
OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI  
ISSUANCE, SALE AND DELIVERY OF SAID BONDS  
(DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT - INFORMATION  
TECHNOLOGY DATA CENTER IMPROVEMENTS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4985, Bill No. 34 (2019), is amended by  
amending Section 1 to read as follows:

“SECTION 1. Authorization of General Obligation Bonds. Pursuant to Chapter 47, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, and particularly Part I thereof, there are hereby authorized to be issued and sold from time to time general obligation bonds of the County of Maui, State of Hawaii (the "County") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed [~~\$51,394,000~~] \$51,744,000 (the "Bonds"), the proceeds derived from the sale of which shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of appropriations for the public improvements of the County described in Section 2 hereof.”

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4985, Bill No. 34 (2019), is amended by  
amending Section 2 to read as follows:

“SECTION 2. Disposition of Bond Proceeds. All or any portion of the proceeds derived from the sale of the Bonds or any notes issued in anticipation of the Bonds shall be used to pay all or part of the cost of any of the public improvements listed below in accordance with appropriations contained in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, including amendments and supplements thereto, duly approved by the Council of the County (the "Council") for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (the "Fiscal Year 2020 Budget"); provided, however, that pursuant to Section 47-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the part of such proceeds which are in excess of the amounts required for the purposes for which the Bonds are initially issued from time to time, or which may not be applied to such purposes, or which the Council deems should not be applied to such

purposes, may be applied to finance such other public improvements of the County as the Council shall, by ordinance approved by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of all of its members, determine; and provided further that the actual use and application of the proceeds of Bonds issued pursuant to this ordinance shall not in any way affect the validity or legality of such Bonds. No proceeds of the Bonds shall be applied to any public improvement listed in this section unless and until there shall be a valid appropriation of general obligation bond proceeds in effect for such public improvement. The public improvements provided for or to be provided for in the Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, to be financed with proceeds from the sale of the Bonds, are as follows:

The cost of issuance of the Bonds or any series thereof, including without limitation, the initial fee of paying agents and registrars, the fees of financial consultants and bond counsel, the cost of preparation of any Official Statement relating to the Bonds, any notices of sale and forms of bid and the definitive Bonds, and the costs of publication of any notices of sale, may be paid from the proceeds of the Bonds or any series thereof and such costs shall be allocated pro rata to each of the foregoing projects financed from such proceeds.”

SECTION 3. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
