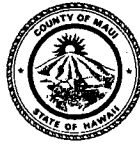

SUBJECT: CONFLICTS BETWEEN CHAPTER 2.96, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING POLICY, AND CHAPTER 3.35, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND (AH-23)
