A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6.04, MAUI COUNTY  
CODE, RELATING TO ANIMAL CONTROL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 6.04.010, Maui County Code, is amended by adding  
new definitions to be appropriately inserted and to read as follows:

“Animal husbandry” is the branch of agriculture concerned with animals that are raised for meat, fiber, milk, eggs, or other products. It includes day-to-day care, selective breeding, and the raising of livestock.

“Livestock” are domesticated animals raised in an agricultural setting to produce commodities such as meat, milk, leather, and wool.”

SECTION 2. Section 6.04.105, Maui County Code, is amended to read as  
follows:

**“6.04.105 - Exemptions.** This chapter shall not apply to:

A. Persons who harvest aquatic life to be used for bait for fishing or for human consumption, or for sale for human consumption[;].

B. Persons exercising those rights customarily and traditionally exercised for subsistence, cultural, and religious purposes and possessed by [ahupu`a] ahupua`a tenants who are descendants of native Hawaiians who inhabited the Hawaiian islands prior to 1778, as protected by article XII, section 7, of the Hawaii State Constitution[; or].


C. Persons who specialize in the holding of aquatic life in a state of captivity within the County for education or scientific study and do not sell or distribute aquatic life for compensation.

D. Persons engaged in animal husbandry or the livestock industry with the intention of harvesting livestock for human consumption or other commodities.”

SECTION 3. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
