ACTING ON THE NOMINATIONS OF FAITH
CHASE, SHAROL ANN LAY, AND BAILEY JUNE
SPRY TO THE HĀNA ADVISORY COMMITTEE
TO THE MAUI PLANNING COMMISSION,
UNDER CHAPTER 2.28, MAUI COUNTY CODE

WHEREAS, the Hāna Advisory Committee to the Maui Planning Commission was formed and operates with seven members and two alternates under Chapter 2.28, Maui County Code; and

WHEREAS, two vacancies will occur on the Hāna Advisory Committee to the Maui Planning Commission, when existing terms expire on March 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated December 31, 2025, the Independent Nomination Board transmitted to the Council three nominations; which are listed in Exhibit "A" with corresponding applications in Exhibit "D," including necessary redactions to protect confidential information; and

WHEREAS, under Section 13-2(17) of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, the Council has 30 days, or until January 30, 2026, to approve the appointment of nominations to fill the vacancies; and

WHEREAS, under Charter Section 13-2(20), if the Council does not approve one or more of the nominations, the Council will notify the Independent Nomination Board by January 30, 2026, and request a new list of nominees; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That, under Chapter 2.28, Maui County Code, it approves the appointment of the persons listed in Exhibit "B," as members to the Hāna Advisory Committee to the Maui Planning Commission for the terms specified;

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2. That it disapproves the nominations listed in Exhibit "C," as members to the Hāna Advisory Committee to the Maui Planning Commission;
3. That the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to the appointed members for their willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
4. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Independent Nomination Board, the Corporation Counsel, the Planning Director, and the Maui Planning Commission.
