EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON REAL PROPERTY TAX REFORM

WHEREAS, Resolution 25-143, FD1 established the Special Committee on Real Property Tax Reform to recommend amendments to Chapter 3.48, Maui County Code, on the assessment, classification, exemption, valuation, and collection of real property taxes; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 25-143, FD1 provides that the Special Committee's term will expire on December 31, 2025, unless extended by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the Special Committee requires additional time to complete its work and prepare recommendations and a committee report for Council consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Council further finds that extending the Special Committee's term through March 27, 2026, will allow the Special Committee to hold remaining meetings and submit related legislation in time for the Council to consider; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That the term of the Special Committee on Real Property Tax Reform established in Resolution 25-143, FD1 is extended so that the Special Committee's term will expire on March 27, 2026, unless extended by resolution;
2. That, except as provided in this Resolution, all provisions of Resolution 25-143, FD1 remain in full force and effect; and
3. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Managing Director, the Director of Finance, the Corporation Counsel, and the Director of Council Services.
