Chair and Members:

Your Budget, Finance, and Economic Development Committee, having met on October 31, 2023, makes reference to Bill 96 (2023), entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, WAILUKU AND WEST MAUI ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL, AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS."

Bill 96's purpose is to amend the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget by amending Section 3.B.10.c.(2).(iv), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Wailuku Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs; and Section 3.B.10.c.(2).(xxix), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, West Maui Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs; to update the fiscal sponsor for ReTree Hawai'i from "Lōkahi Pacific" to "Nā Koa Manu Conservation."

According to their website, ReTree Hawaii, LLC's goals are to:

- "Reach everyone in Hawaii with information about the climate crisis. . .";
- "Plant a very large number of trees in every region of every major island":
- "Energize and accelerate the climate crisis work and the climate adaptation work across Hawaii"; and
- "Create new working relationships between organizations and individuals to further the climate crisis work."

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According to nkmconservation.org, one of the services Nā Koa Manu Conservation, Inc. provides is to "support on-going and/or initiate forest and watershed restoration efforts in Hawaii for the benefit of native Hawaiian birds' habitats."

Your Committee notes the purposes of ReTree Hawaii, LLC and Nā Koa Manu Conservation, Inc. are complementary in their efforts to support the environment.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of Bill 96 (2023) on first reading. Committee Chair Sugimura and members Cook, Johnson, Lee, Paltin, Rawlins-Fernandez, Sinenci, and U'u-Hodgins voted "aye." Committee Vice-Chair Kama was excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of Bill 96, CD1 (2023), approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions.

Your Budget, Finance, and Economic Development Committee RECOMMENDS that Bill 96, CD1 (2023), as revised herein and attached hereto, entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI, OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, WAILUKU AND WEST MAUI ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL, AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS," be PASSED ON FIRST READING and be ORDERED TO PRINT.
