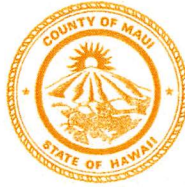

URGING THE HAWAII STATE LEGISLATURE TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE TO ESTABLISH A SURCHARGE ON GENERAL EXCISE TAX

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Act 11 Session Laws of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, codified as Section 46-16.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, established a deadline of May 31, 2019 for Counties to establish a surcharge on general excise tax; and

WHEREAS, the County now desires to establish a surcharge on general excise tax; and


WHEREAS, In order for the County to establish said surcharge it needs an extension of the deadline; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it urges the State Legislature to enact legislation extending the date for County has until to establish a surcharge on state tax; and

2. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor; Senate President, Ronald D. Kouchi; House Speaker, Scott K. Saiki; Senate Ways and Means Committee Chair, Donovan M. Dela Cruz; and House Finance Committee Chair, Sylvia Luke.
