A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI,  
OFFICE OF THE MAYOR, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM,  
GRANTS AND DISBURSEMENTS FOR BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT  
AND TECHNOLOGY, WAILUKU ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,  
ENVIRONMENTAL, AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:


SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5657, Bill No. 60, CD1, FD2 (2024), as amended "Fiscal Year 2025 Budget", Section 3.B.12.c.(2).(xxviii), Office of the Mayor, Economic Development Program, Grants and disbursements for business development and technology, Wailuku Economic Development, Environmental, and Cultural Programs, is amended to increase the condition for Imi 'Pono: The Greatest Challenge, in the amount of \$5,000, delete the condition for Maui Economic Opportunity, Inc., and increase the condition for Paukukalo Hawaiian Homes Community Association, Inc., in the amount of \$15,000 for improvements and community events, to read as follows:


