A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI,  
DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE, COUNTYWIDE COSTS;  
DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT; APPENDIX A, PART I,  
DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT; AND APPENDIX A, PART II,  
EMERGENCY FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 5528, Bill No. 22, CD1, FD2 (2023), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2024 Budget", Section 3.B.5.g.(12), Department of Finance, Countywide Costs, Transfer to the Emergency Fund, is amended by decreasing the appropriation under Category B by \$20,603,895 and adjusting the total accordingly, to read as follows:

SECTION 2. Fiscal Year 2024 Budget Section 3.B.9, Department of Management is amended to add a new program titled "Office of Recovery" with an appropriation for Category A in the amount of \$403,895, and appropriation for Category B in the amount of \$20,200,000, and a total appropriation of \$20,603,895 to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Fiscal Year 2024 Budget Appendix A, Part I, Grants and Restricted Use Revenues – Schedule of Grants and Restricted Use Revenues by Departments and Programs for Fiscal Year 2024, Department of Management is amended by adding a new grant entitled "Private Donations" in the amount of \$200,000, to read as follows:

Fiscal Year 2024 Budget Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2024, Section J, Emergency Fund, is amended by reducing the appropriation in the amount of \$20,603,895 and adjusting the total accordingly, and adding new conditional language for a Lahaina Wildfire Final Disposition Site and Department of Fire and Public Safety, to read as follows:

- (3) Up to \$1,200,000 must be for the Department of Fire and Public Safety for costs related to the August 2023 Maui Wildfires including the replacement of apparatus lost in the fires.
