Chair and Members:

Your Economic Development and Budget Committee, having met on January 23, 2020, makes reference to County Communication 20-20, from the Budget Director, transmitting the following:

A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE 1. AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES: DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, SPECIAL MAINTENANCE PROGRAM **GENERAL** FUND; COUNTYWIDE, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, HIGHWAY FUND; MAKAWAO-PUKALANI-KULA COMMUNITY PLAN AREA, ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, HIGHWAY FUND; TOTAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS: AND TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)" (Budget bill).

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2020 Budget by 1) increasing Carryover/Savings from the Highway Fund by \$546,000; 2) amending Section 3.B.15.c.(3), Department of Public Works, Maintenance Program - General Fund, by expanding the scope of proviso (3), relating to the Kahana Nui Desilting Basin; and 3) amending under the Department of Public Works a) Section 4.G.1.c.(2).(iv), Countywide, Road Improvements, Highway Fund, by increasing appropriation for "Countywide Traffic Calming Program" by \$80,000; and b) Section 4.G.4.a, Makawao-Pukalani-Kula Community Plan Area, Road Improvements, by adding "(2)

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Highway Fund" and appropriations for capital projects entitled "Old Haleakala Highway Traffic Signal Upgrade at Pukalani Street," in the amount of \$200,000, and "Guardrail and Shoulder Improvements at Various Locations," in the amount of \$266,000.

2. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI AS IT PERTAINS TO APPENDIX C - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS (COUNTYWIDE TRAFFIC CALMING PROGRAM; OLD HALEAKALA HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADE AT PUKALANI STREET; GUARDRAIL AND SHOULDER IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS)" (Capital bill).

The purpose of the proposed bill is to amend the FY 2020 Budget, Appendix C, Capital Improvement Projects, by amending under the Department of Public Works the project description for the Countywide Traffic Calming Program and increasing its appropriation by \$80,000; and by adding under the Makawao-Pukalani-Kula Community Plan Area two projects and project descriptions entitled "Old Haleakala Highway Traffic Signal Upgrade at Pukalani Street" and "Guardrail and Shoulder Improvements at Various Locations" with appropriations of \$200,000 and \$266,000, respectively.

3. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2020 Budget, dated January 3, 2020, for \$546,000 in Carryover/Savings from the Highway Fund.

A representative from the Department of Public Works said the Department has removed approximately 30 percent of the sediment material from the Kahana Nui Desilting Basin. The basin had between 30,000 to 40,000 cubic yards of sediment. Work to remove the sediment

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continues, but the Department will also be able to remove sediment from other dams in West Maui with the revisions to proviso (3) in the Budget bill.

The representative explained that one reason why the basin is filled with sediment is because the release valve for the basin never functioned properly. The Department is working to redesign the valve.

Your Committee asked for clarification of the capital project entitled "Guardrail and Shoulder Improvements at Various Locations." The Director of Public Works said this project is for five locations along Haliimaile Road.

The Director also explained the capital project entitled "Old Haleakala Highway Traffic Signal Upgrade at Pukalani Street" includes replacing the traffic-signal poles, the signal displays, and the controller cabinet and fixing the signal's vehicle-detection capabilities. Eighty percent of the project's cost will be covered by federal funding. The County will cover the remaining 20 percent with the \$200,000 appropriation.

Your Committee voted 8-0 to recommend passage of the proposed bills on first reading and filing of the communication. Committee Chair Rawlins-Fernandez, Vice-Chair King, and members Hokama, Kama, Lee, Molina, Sinenci, and Sugimura voted "aye." Committee member Paltin was excused.

Your Committee is in receipt of a revised proposed Budget bill, approved as to form and legality by the Department of the Corporation Counsel, incorporating nonsubstantive revisions, including adjustments to reflect the expected passage of other pending legislation.
