SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET

I am transmitting the attached proposed bills for the purpose of adding appropriations to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 Budget for the capital improvement projects entitled, "Kihei No. 16 Pump Station Rehabilitation and Force Main Replacement", in the amount of \$1,010,000 under the State Revolving Loan Fund and "Lahaina Wastewater" Pump Station No. 3 Modifications", in the amount of \$110,000 under the Sewer Fund.

In FY 2016, the Kihei No. 16 Pump Station Rehabilitation and Force Main Replacement project was appropriated \$4,400,000 through the State of Hawaii's Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund. Due to higher than anticipated construction costs, an additional \$1,010,000 is needed in FY 2017 to complete the project.

The Lahaina Wastewater Pump Station No. 3 Modifications project received a \$1,600,000 appropriation in FY 2016. Due to higher than anticipated construction costs. an additional \$110,000 is needed in FY 2017 to complete the project. The additional appropriation will be funded by increasing Carryover/Savings Sewer Fund in the amount of \$110,000. Attached for your information is a Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2017 to certify the availability of Sewer Fund Carryover/Savings.

The attached bills replace a budget amendment proposing to fund the above mentioned projects through the Countywide Sewer Capital Improvement Reserved Fund which was transmitted on January 13, 2017.

CONTROL REVOLVING FUND FOR VARIOUS WASTEWATER PROJECTS,
FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4226, Bill No. 33 (2015), authorized the County of Maui to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for a State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund Loan in the amount of \$4,400,000 for the Kihei No. 16 Pump Station Rehabilitation and Force Main Replacement project. The project requires an additional \$1,010,000 in funding.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 4320, Bill No. 48 (2016), is amended by amending Section 1 to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Request for Loan. The County of Maui, pursuant to Section 342D-83 through Section 342D-87, Hawaii Revised Statutes, has submitted an application for State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund Loans ("SRF loans") to the Director of the Department of Health, State of Hawaii, to finance the following projects:

a.	Kulanihakoi Street Recycled Water Line Extension
b.	Lahaina Wastewater Reclamation Facility (WWRF) Modifications, Stage 1A
c.	Sheraton Wastewater Pump Station Modifications \$1,000,000
d.	Countywide Wastewater Reclamation Facility (WWRF) Chlorination System Upgrade

- e. Wailuku-Kahului Wastewater Reclamation Facility
 Solids Building Renovation\$1,000,000
- <u>Kihei No. 16 Pump Station Rehabilitation</u> and Force Main Replacement.....\$ 1,010,000

Under the terms and conditions anticipated with regard to each such SRF loan, the County shall repay, over a term of twenty years, the principal amount, which shall not exceed the amount of each such loan stated above, at a fixed rate of interest that shall not exceed the Bond Buyer's 20-year general obligation bond issue."

SECTION 3. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
