AGENDA**KA PAPA KUMUMANA‘O****BILL 1 (2026), AMENDING THE WATER AVAILABILITY POLICY ON SUBDIVISION CONSTRUCTION PLANS (WAI-21)****PILA 1 (2026), E HO‘OLOLI ANA I KA MANA‘O HO‘OKŌ HO‘OLAKO WAI NO NĀ MANA‘O HO‘OKELE KŪKULU KAIAHALE (WAI-21)**

Description: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. Bill 1 (2026), entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WATER AVAILABILITY POLICY ON SUBDIVISION CONSTRUCTION PLANS.” Bill 1’s purpose is to allow the Department of Water Supply to review subdivision construction plans, at the subdivider’s risk of water availability, before the verification of a private or public long-term supply of water.
2. An Amendment Summary Form, dated July 28, 2026, from the Committee Chair, with a proposed CD1 version of Bill 1 (2026), entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WATER AVAILABILITY POLICY AND SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE ON SUBDIVISION CONSTRUCTION PLANS.”
The proposed CD1 version:
 - 1) Amends Section 1 to state that the written verification requirement for a long-term water supply must not delay the Department of Water Supply’s review of, and comments on, subdivision construction plans.
 - 2) Amends Subsection 14.12.040(A), Maui County Code, by restoring the language regarding written verification requirements.
 - 3) Adds a new Subsection C to Code Section 14.12.040, stating that the required written verification must not delay the Director’s review of and comments on subdivision construction plans, and that such review may proceed concurrently with other departmental reviews and comments.
 - 4) Makes nonsubstantive and technical revisions for clarity, consistency, and style.

He Palapala Hō‘ulu‘ulu ‘Ōlelo Ho‘ololi, ua ho‘opa‘a manawa ‘ia ma Iulai 28, 2026, mai Ka Luna Ho‘omalua Kōmike, me kekahi ‘ano CD1 i hāpai ‘ia o ka Pila 1 (2026), ua kapa ‘ia ‘o “HE PILA NO KEKAHI KĀNĀWAI KŪLOKO E HO‘OLOLI ANA I KA MANA‘O HO‘OKŌ HO‘OLAKO WAI A ME KE KĀNĀWAI KŪLOKO KAIAHALE NO NĀ MANA‘O HO‘OKELE KŪKULU KAIAHALE.” ‘O ke ‘ano CD1 i hāpai ‘ia:
 - 1) E ho‘ololi i ka Paukū 1 e hō‘ike mai i ka ho‘olohi ‘ole ‘ana o ke koina hō‘oia i kākau ‘ia no ka ho‘olako wai i ka manawa lō‘ihi i ko ke Ke‘ena ‘Oihana Wai nānā ‘ana a me ka ha‘i mana‘o ‘ana i nā mana‘o ho‘okele kūkulu kaiahale.
 - 2) E ho‘ololi i ka ‘Āpana 14.12.040(A), ka Papa Kānāwai o ke Kalana o Maui, ma o ka ho‘iho‘i ‘ana i ka ‘ōlelo e pili ana i nā koina hō‘oia i kākau ‘ia.
 - 3) E ho‘opāku‘i i kekahi ‘Āpana C hou i ka ‘Āpana Papa Kānāwai 14.12.040, e hō‘ike ana i ka ho‘olohi ‘ole ‘ana o ka hō‘oia kākau ‘ana i koi ‘ia aku i ko ka Luna nānā ‘ana a me ka ha‘i mana‘o ‘ana i nā mana‘o ho‘okele kūkulu kaiahale, a e ho‘omua aku nō i ka nānā ‘ana a me ka ha‘i mana‘o ‘ana o nā ke‘ena ‘ē a‘e i ka wā like.

- 4) E ho‘ololi i nā mea kiko‘ī no ka mōakaaka, ke kohu pū ‘ana, a me ke kaila.

Status: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of Bill 1 (2026) on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of Bill 1 (2026) and other related action.
