

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF BEVERLY STANICH  
TO THE MAUI COUNTY COMMISSION ON  
PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

WHEREAS, by correspondence dated November 24, 2020, Mayor Michael P. Victorino notified the Council he nominated BEVERLY STANICH to the Maui County Commission on Persons with Disabilities for a term expiring on March 31, 2025, to fill a vacancy replacing Robert Carroll, pursuant to Sections 2.32.020 and 2.32.030, Maui County Code ("MCC"), and Section 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended ("Charter"); and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2, requires the Mayor's nominee to be approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, Charter Section 13-2(17), requires the Council to approve or disapprove the nomination within sixty days after the Mayor submits the name of the nominee to the Council because of the death, resignation, or removal of a member; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That it approves the appointment of BEVERLY STANICH to serve on the Maui County Commission on Persons with Disabilities for a term expiring March 31, 2025;
2. That the Council expresses its gratitude and appreciation to BEVERLY STANICH for her willingness to be considered for public service and actively participate in County government; and
3. That certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, the Managing Director, and the Corporation Counsel.
