He was 63-years-old in 2016 when he died during training in waters off Waikiki.

The Honolulu Star Advertiser reports his son argued a high surf advisory was issued the day of the training session and the Commander wasn't effectively supervising.

Honolulu City Council still has to approve the settlement agreement. The decision is expected on April 14th.
