WHEREAS, by correspondence dated January 23, 2017, Acting Mayor Keith A. Regan notified the Council he nominated Paula Heiskell to the Cost of Government Commission for a term expiring March 31, 2019, to fill a vacancy replacing Annie Alvarado, pursuant to Sections 3-9.3 and 13-2, Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, (“Charter”); and

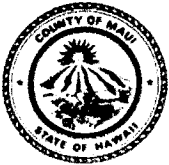
BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:
