

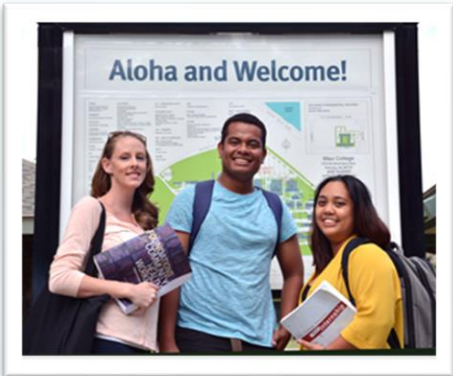

- 294: Fieldwork

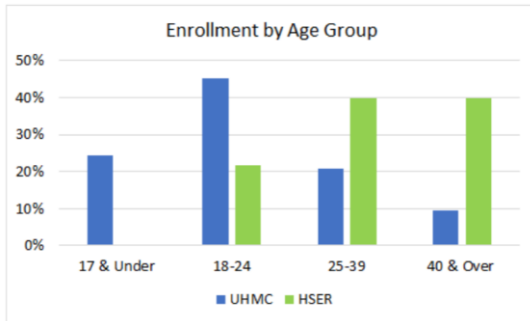


Curriculum Overview
