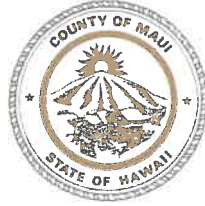

SUBJECT: HAWAIIAN CULTURAL RESTORATION (PRL-26)

In response to your letter dated October 8, 2018, we would like to provide the following response.

1. Could you please confirm whether Friends of Moku'ula ("FOM") has any artifacts from the Moku'ula/Mokuhinia sites in its possession?

RESPONSE: We confirmed that FOM has artifacts currently in their possession.

2. If FOM does have artifacts in its possession, could you please:
 - a. Confirm where the artifacts are being housed, who bears responsibility for those artifacts currently, contact information for the person or entity housing the artifacts, and a summary description of the artifacts.

RESPONSE: The artifacts are currently being housed at FOM's Front Street Office. Blossom Feiteira, a volunteer, is currently responsible for those artifacts. Her contact information is 505 Front Street, #221, Lahaina, Hawaii 96761, phone
