County of Maui Grant Process Feedback Survey

- Responses accepted January 29 - February 15
- Questions developed in collaboration with grantees that approached us with this need
- 28 responses representing 90 grants and grant applications from FY2024 to present (one respondent was a fiscal sponsor with 30 grants over this time period)
- Range of \$25,000 to \$7.2M in grant amounts
- Line-item and competitive grantees
- Fiscal sponsors and direct organizations
- 10 County grantmaking offices or departments

Results

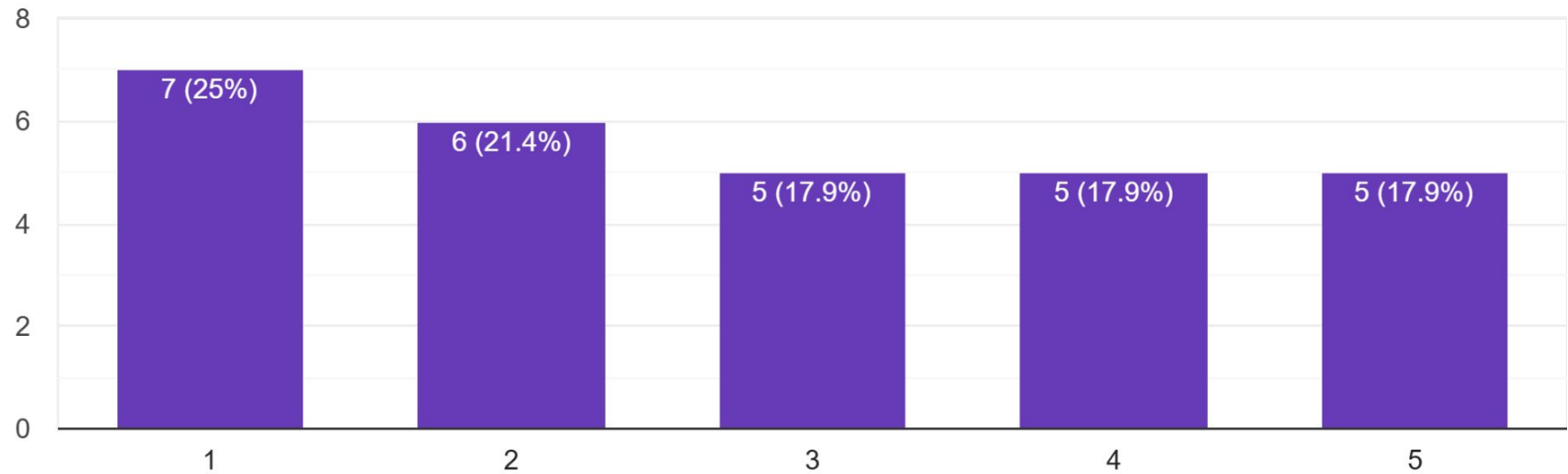
- Respondents primarily serve vulnerable populations and protect the environment and natural resources
- 93% of respondents receive funding from sources other than the County
- Common challenges:
 - 78.6% of respondents find the timely disbursement of funds to be the most challenging part of the grant process
 - 53.6% of respondents say reporting requirements are most challenging

Results

- Asked, “Do you believe that any County actions or decisions regarding your grant (reviews, approvals, denials, advancement, reimbursement, timing, etc.) were made for personal reasons? Or, have you ever chosen to not provide feedback on the County grants process to preserve your relationship with the County?” only 57.1% responded “No”
- Over a 30-day period respondents report awaiting reimbursement for amounts as high as \$1.5M and \$600,000

How would you rate your overall experience with the County of Maui's grant process? Five stars represents an excellent experience, while one star is poor.

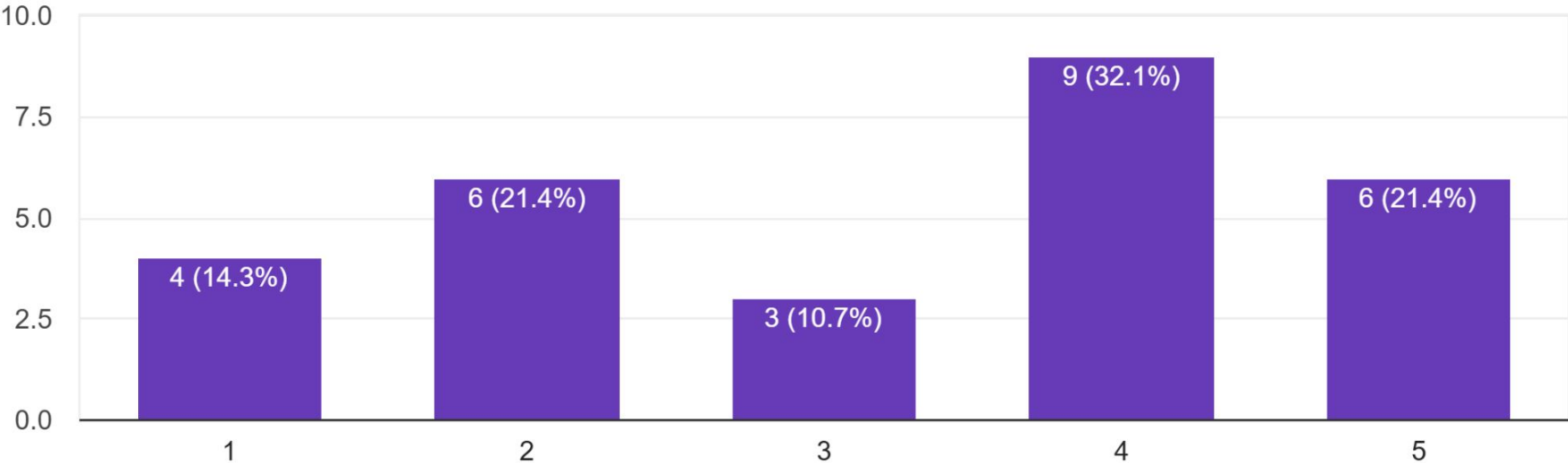

With five stars being excellent and one star being poor, how would you rate the communication and response times between the County of Maui and grantees during the grants process?

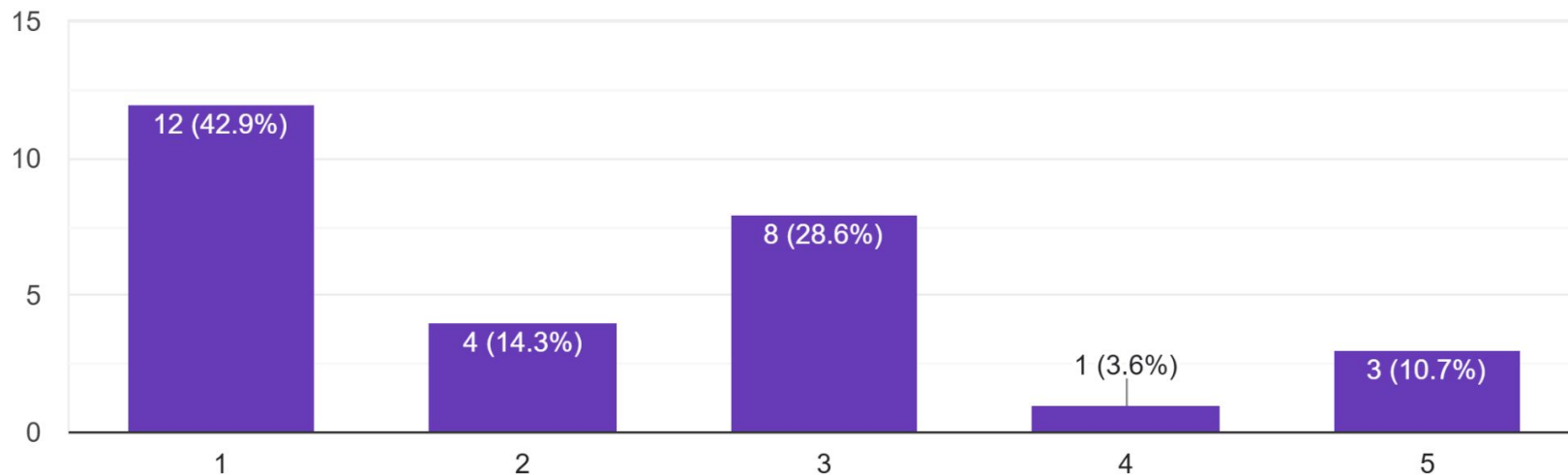

How timely do you find the disbursement of funds from the County of Maui?

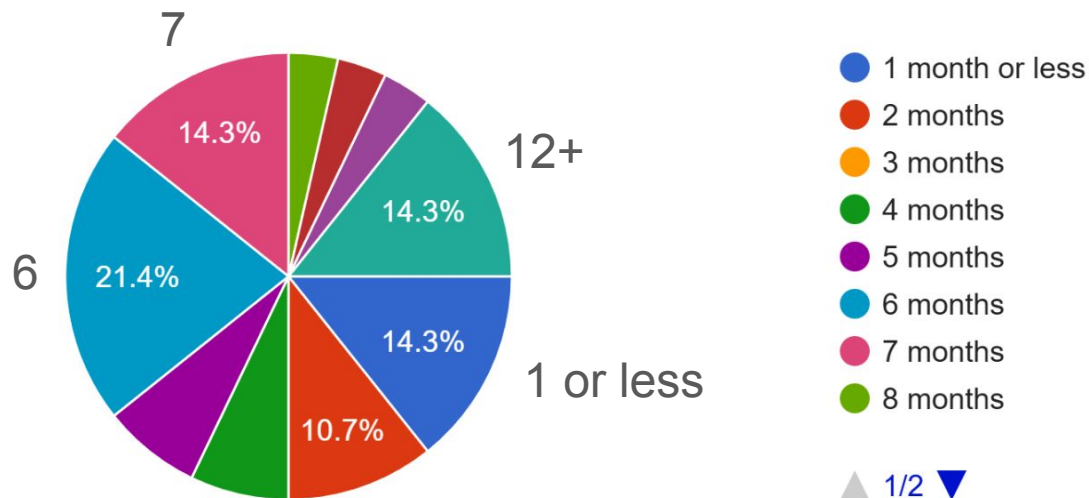

On a scale of “Not timely” to “Very timely”

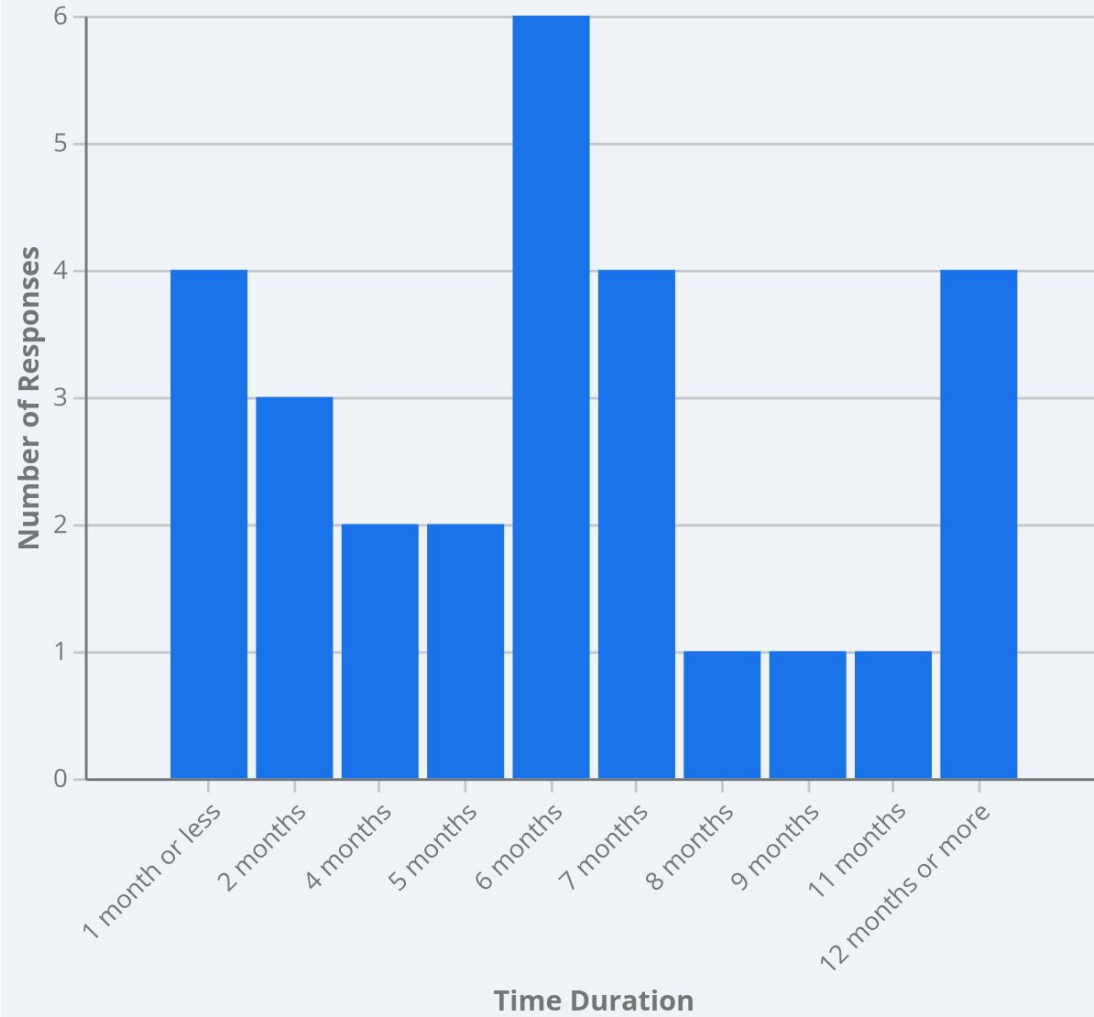
What is the longest you have waited from application submittal to being notified of grant award or denial by the County?

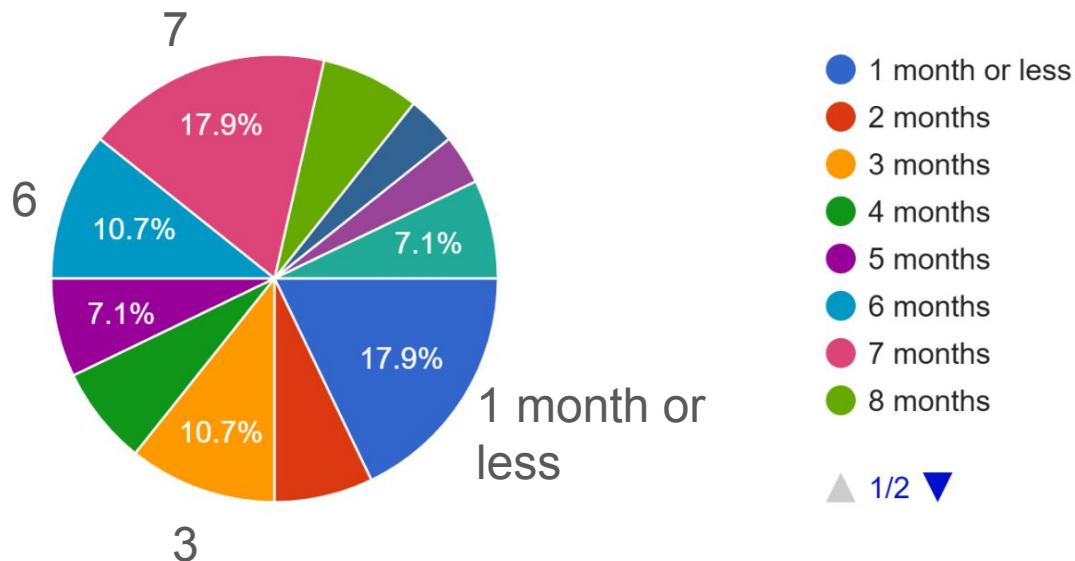

Longest Wait Time: Application to Notification



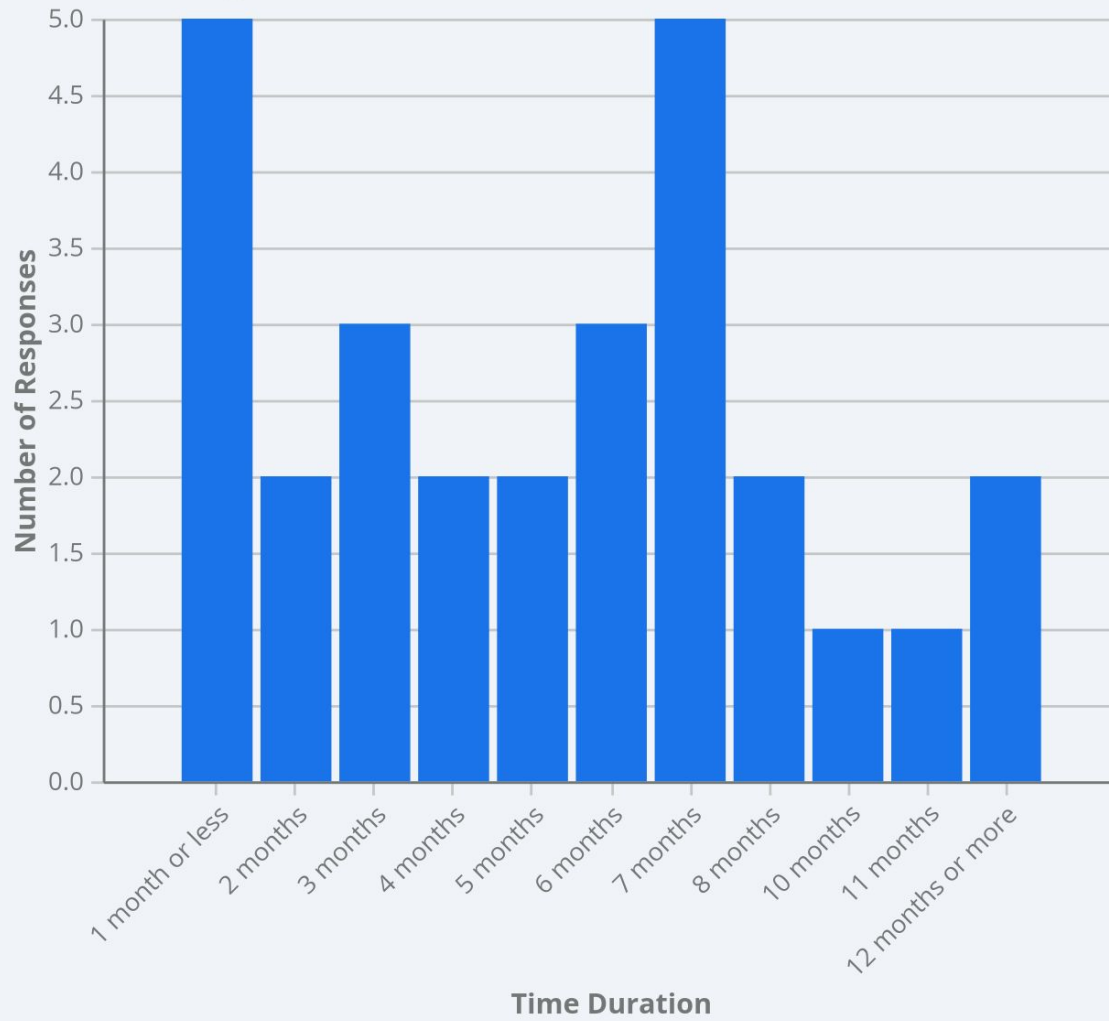
What is the longest you have waited from being notified of a grant award to signing and executing a grant contract with the County?

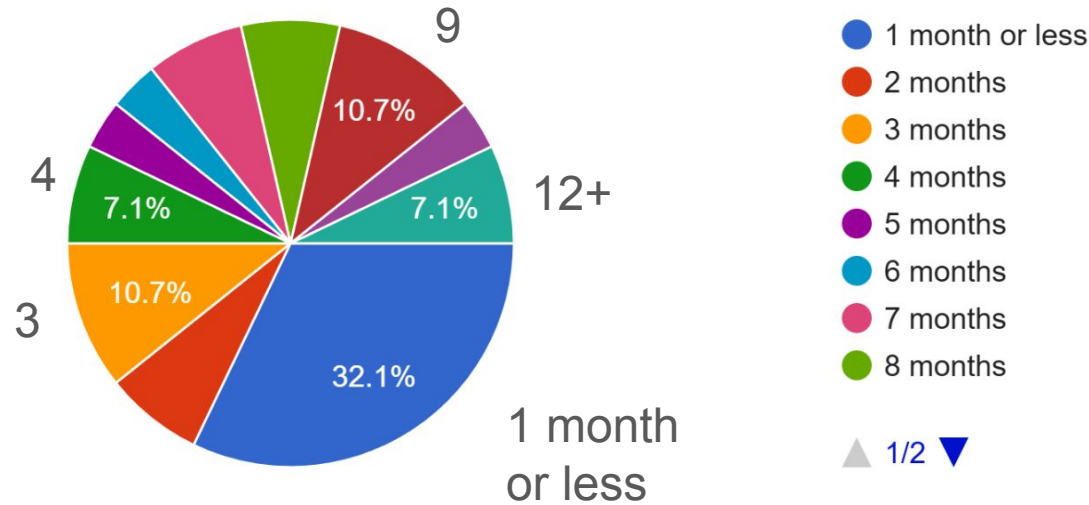

Longest Wait Time: Notification to Contract Execution



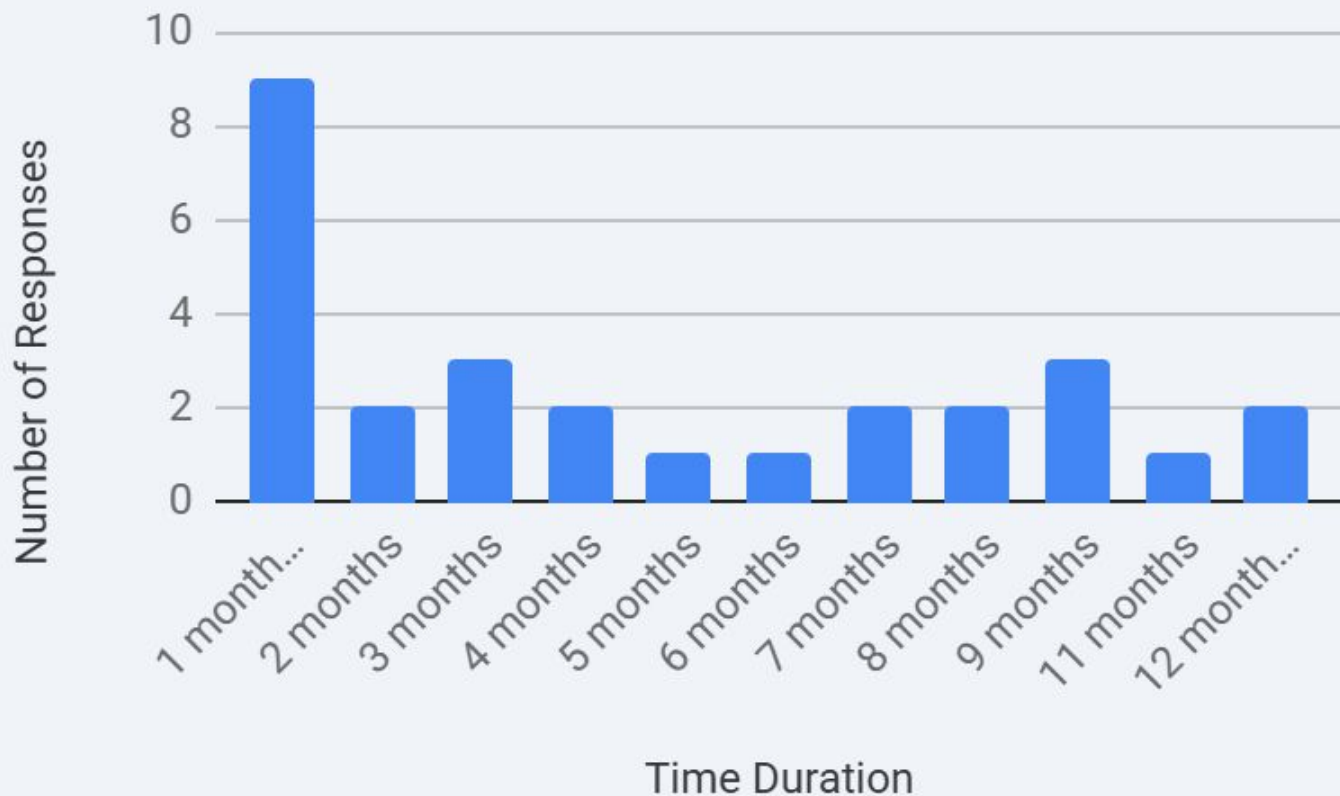
What is the longest you have waited from signing and executing a grant contract to receiving the first grant fund advancement from the County?

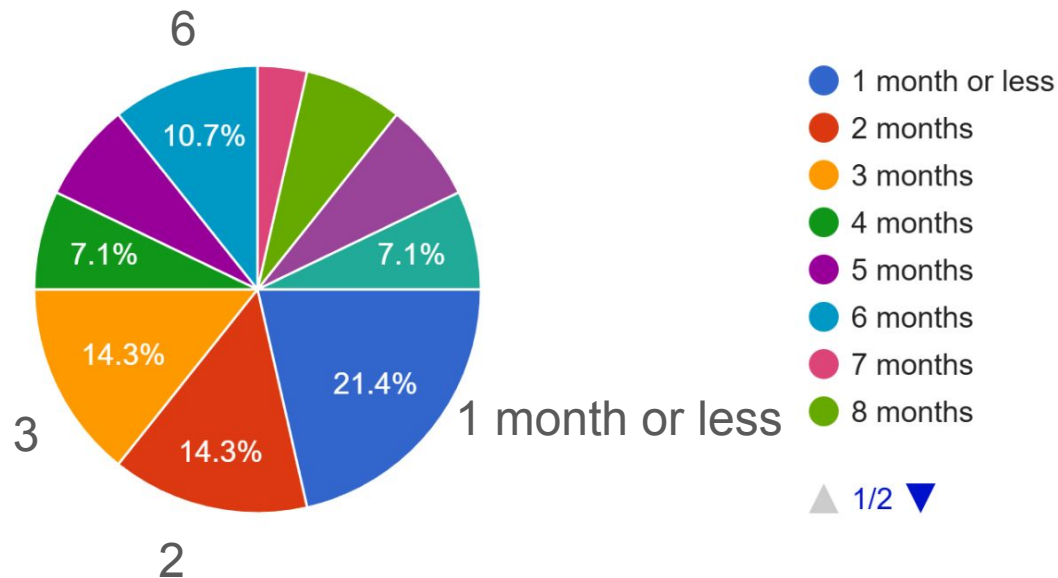

Longest Wait Time: Contract Execution to First Advance



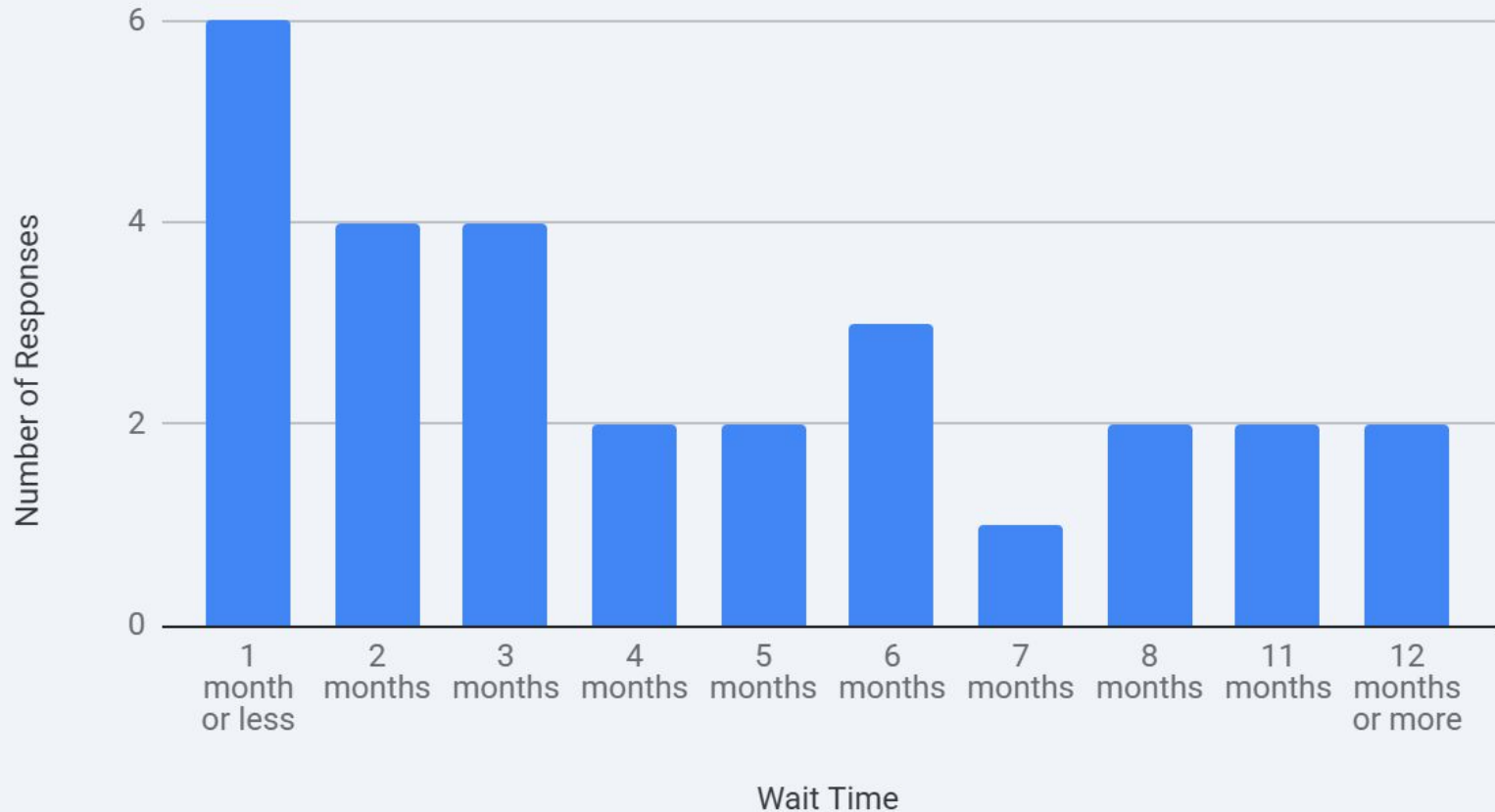
What is the longest you have waited from submitting a reimbursement request to receiving reimbursement for that request from the County?

AI Summary of Feedback, Comments, and Suggestions for Improvement

- Reimbursement and Payment Delays
 - The current **reimbursement process causes significant financial strain, project delays, and cash flow issues** for many organizations, especially smaller non-profits, with wait times extending over six months and some never receiving the advance they sought.
- Process Efficiency and Bureaucracy
 - The entire grant process is described as cumbersome, repetitive, overly granular, and lengthy, with numerous required signatures (including the Mayor's) and **excessive bureaucratic scrutiny** on reimbursement requests.
- Technology and Transparency
 - A strong need exists for modernizing county systems, with requests for a **centralized** electronic portal, automatic online processing with **full transparency on application status**, and improved user-friendliness for platforms like Amplified and Submittable, including providing Word templates for writing proposals.
- Need for Clearer Guidelines and Timelines
 - Grantees requested **set timelines for the grant process** (e.g., 30 days for payment after submission), clearer written guidelines, consistent expectations from staff, and **a cultural shift where non-profits are viewed as trusted partners rather than approached solely through a compliance lens.**
- Positive Staff Feedback
 - Despite the systemic issues, several respondents praised the individual efforts, responsiveness, and helpfulness of **specific county staff members and grant managers.**

Reimbursement Process

Maui County Code

3.36.190 - Disbursement.

Recipients of grants are eligible for upfront **disbursement** of twenty-five percent or more of grant funds, and **any remaining grant funds must be paid through the agency's reimbursement process**.

Proposal

Recipients of County monetary grants are eligible for upfront **disbursements** of grant funds based on a determination of need. Grant funds must be paid under the grant agreement terms and conditions. The agency must notify grant applicants and grant recipients of their eligibility for upfront disbursements under this section.
