 - b. If the County does not select third-party inspectors, would this create a conflict of interest? How is independence between the inspector and the factory ensured?
 - c. What training or licensure is required for third-party inspectors? Are they required to hold a journeyman's license?

- 4. How does the Quality Assurance Manual meet or exceed the County's inspection and construction requirements?
- 5. If the Council enacts Bill 122 (2025), what is the Department's anticipated timeline for implementation?
- 6. Regarding warranties:
 - a. What types of warranties apply to factory-built homes compared to traditionally-built homes (e.g., 10-year warranty)?
 - b. Does the warranty period begin at the time of construction or once the home is placed on the property?
 - c. Are warranties in place during transport?
- 7. Regarding Design Registered Homes:
 - a. Does the "Design Registered Homes" process further reduce construction timelines for factory-built homes compared to traditional construction? If so, please explain.
 - b. If not, do timelines for factory-built homes remain similar to traditional construction despite this process?
