A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 3.26. MAUI COUNTY
CODE, RELATING TO EMPLOYEE PARKING FEES FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:


SECTION 1. This Ordinance's purpose is to repeal the employee parking fees fund.

SECTION 2. Chapter 3.26, Maui County Code, is repealed.

SECTION 3. All encumbrances and any balance remaining in the employee parking fees fund must be transferred to the general fund.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.


