BILL NO. **119, CD1** (2025)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.36.040, MAUI COUNTY CODE, ON PENALTIES FOR PROHIBITED NOISE VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Section 9.36.040, Maui County Code, is amended to read as follows:

“9.36.040 Penalty. A. For the first offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [of not less than \$25 but no more than \$100.] is \$500.


B. For the second offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [or not less than \$100 but no more than \$250.] is \$750.

C. For the third offense, upon conviction, [there shall be a] the fine [of not less than \$250 but no more than \$500.] is \$1,000.”

SECTION 2. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. In printing this bill, the County Clerk need not include the brackets, the bracketed material, or the underscoring.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect on approval.
