AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN
UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCE
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND HUMAN
CONCERNS, FISCAL YEAR 2024 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Section 9-10(2) of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended (“Charter”), provides that, upon written request of the Mayor, part or all of any unencumbered appropriation balance may be transferred within a department by resolution or from one department to another by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions in Ordinance No. 5528, Bill No. 22, CD1, FD2 (2023), as amended, (“Fiscal Year 2024 Budget”), states that, unless otherwise provided, appropriations for each program may be disbursed for the following categories of use: (A) salaries, premium pay, or reallocation pay, and (B) operations, services, and equipment; provided the disbursement is within the program and category of use for which it was appropriated; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.B.7.c.(6).(xi) of the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget, relating to the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, Human Concerns Program, Grants and disbursements for youth centers and programs, sets forth appropriations for Youth Programs; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 9-10(2) of the Charter, Mayor Richard T. Bissen, Jr. has submitted a written request to transfer an unencumbered appropriation balance of \$50,000 within the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, Human Concerns Program, Grants and disbursements for youth centers and programs, from the conditional language stating “Up to \$280,000 must be for the Boys and Girls Club – Mookai”, to the line item for Youth Programs, Category B (Operations & Equipment), in order to provide a \$50,000 grant to Aha Kukui O Moloka`i; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Maui:

1. That, pursuant to Section 9-10(2) of the Charter and Section 7 of the General Budget Provisions, and in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget, it does hereby authorize the transfer of an unencumbered

appropriation balance of \$50,000 within the Department of Housing and Human Concerns, Human Concerns Program, Grants and disbursements for youth centers and programs, from the conditional language stating “Up to \$280,000 must be for the Boys and Girls Club – Mookai”, to the line item for Youth Programs, Category B (Operations & Equipment), in order to provide a \$50,000 grant to Aha Kukui O Moloka`i; and

2. That certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the Mayor, Managing Director, Director of Finance, and Budget Director.
