SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2017 BUDGET

On behalf of the Department of Parks and Recreation, I am transmitting the attached proposed bill for the purpose of increasing the appropriation in the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget under the Department of Parks and Recreation, Waiehu Golf Course Program due to a projected shortfall in premium pay as a result of ongoing improvement and disease control projects that must be scheduled after hours when the course is free of golfers. The department has provided the attached justification for your review.

The proposed increase will be funded by increasing Carryover/Savings Golf Fund and Estimated Revenues in the amount of \$16,200. A Certification of Additional Revenues for Fiscal Year 2017 to certify the availability of Golf Fund Carryover/Savings is attached for your information.

The Department of Parks and Recreation requests that this budget amendment be considered as soon as possible. I respectfully request that this matter be referred to the appropriate Council committee for expeditious review, discussion and appropriate action. ## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. ## <u>JUSTIFICATION</u>

CURRENT IMPROVEMENT/DISEASE CONTROL PROJECTS AT THE WAIEHU GOLF COURSE REQUIRING ADDITIONAL PREMIUM PAY (OVERTIME) FUNDING:

## **Weed Eradication Program**

Currently staff at the Waiehu Golf Course are spot spraying around the greens and tees to kill and remove weed seeds and Goosegrass weeds before they continue to spread more weeds onto the greens. Time is expended coordinating mowing and irrigation schedules, and scheduling work when the course is free of golfers. Thus, there is a need to provide overtime to accomplish this to ensure safety of all on site. Additionally, providing a better playing condition will assist in the increase in revenue.

### Tee Box Re-grassing

The Waiehu Golf Course staff is currently working on re-grassing fourteen (14) tee boxes with Seashore Paspalum grass. This project requires the need to use equipment when course is not in use and after scheduled work hours. Additionally, staff will be required to do more fertilizing of these tees once regrassed.

#### **Greens Conversion to SeaStar Seashore Paspalum Grass**

The Waiehu Golf Course Program has encumbered funds for the grass sprigs to accomplish the re-grassing on 9 holes of greens. This will be a difficult job to do during golfing play and will be even harder to grow in with play on those same greens. Therefore, coordination and planning is required by the supervisory staff to move this project forward and keep the course open when the project is started. With the daily management of the golf course, and lack of a clerical position, the supervisory staff is required to do this project management and clerical tasks after normal work hours.
