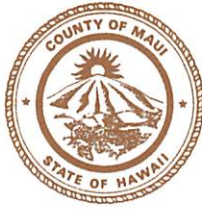

SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET

On behalf of the Department of Parks and Recreation, I am transmitting the attached proposed bill for the purpose of adding a \$200,000 appropriation in the Fiscal Year 2018 Budget under the Department of Public Works, Road, Bridge, and Drainage Maintenance Program – Highway Fund for the removal of dead trees in the county owned rights of way on Lana'i.

The \$200,000 appropriation will be funded by increasing Carryover/Savings Highway Fund and Estimated Revenues in the amount of \$200,000. A Certification of Additional Revenue for Fiscal Year 2018 certifying the availability of Highway Fund Carryover/Savings is attached.

There are approximately 50 dead Cook Pine trees in the county owned rights of way on Lana'i that require removal. Before Lana'i's heavy winds cause the trees to fall and cause property damage, injury or death, the department requests this budget amendment in order to proceed with the removal of the dead trees for the protection of Lana'i residents and visitors.

While the funding is being appropriated under the Department of Public Works, the Department of Parks and Recreation will be managing the project.

As safety of our community continues to be a top priority, the Department of Parks & Recreation requests that this budget amendment be considered at your earliest opportunity. Thank you in advance for considering our request.

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI
AS IT PERTAINS TO ESTIMATED REVENUES;
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS,
ROAD, BRIDGE, AND DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM – HIGHWAY FUND;
TOTAL OPERATING APPROPRIATIONS; AND
TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS (OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4456, Bill No. 65 (2017), Draft 1, as amended, "Fiscal Year 2018 Budget", is hereby amended as it pertains to Section 2, Estimated Revenues, by increasing Carryover/Savings from the Highway Fund in the amount of \$200,000; and by increasing Total Estimated Revenues in the amount of \$200,000, to read as follows:
