1. Whether forfeiture funds can be used to assist with maintaining equipment acquired from the DOD under the LESO program.

Yes. Permissible uses of forfeiture funds includes the costs associated with the purchase, lease, maintenance or operation of law enforcement equipment for use by law enforcement personnel that supports law enforcement activities.
